The Cause: Radon

Radon is a colorless, odorless, tasteless, naturally occurring radioactive gas that comes from the soil. Radon seeps into homes from the ground, collects inside the home, and then is inhaled by the residents. The U.S. Surgeon General states that it is the leading cause of lung cancer among non-smokers in the United States. Testing for radon is the only way to detect the level of radon present inside the home.

The Goal: Raise Awareness

By raising awareness of the harmful effects of radon, the number of homes with high levels of radon can decrease. This contest is designed to raise awareness about radon testing, mitigation, and to inform the public of the dangers of long-term exposure to elevated indoor radon gas.

Video Requirements

- Be an original video by students 10-14 years old.
- Be sure the information that you put in your video is correct.
- Be CREATIVE! (Think outside the box.)
- Topic and title must be on the Video Submission Form.
- Video should be no longer than 60 seconds.
- Videos should be themed around promoting public awareness of radon gas risks and home testing. Videos could be used for informational purposes, accuracy is imperative. Messages should be short and accurate.
- Videos shall not contain violence, profanity, or direct attacks on individuals or organizations. Submissions having content deemed inappropriate or offensive by these or any other means will not be judged.
- Copyrighted characters, product logos and trademarked or brand names cannot be used.
