INDIVIDUAL CONSIDERATION

1. Aline Kassaharra (Application by Examination)

Ms. Kassaharra was present.

Ms. Aline Kassaharra submitted an Application by Examination. She graduated from Sao Camilo University Center in Brazil with a bachelor's degree of Science in Nutrition in January 21, 2011. A credential evaluation was received from Josef Silny & Associates, INC with a course-by-course evaluation of Ms. Kassaharra's undergraduate study at Sao Camilo University Center in terms of U.S.

courses, semester credit hours and grades which reflects the equivalent of the U.S. degree of Bachelor of Science in Nutrition earned at a regionally accredited institution of higher education in the United States. Ms. Kassahara's application originally requested to use experience in lieu of 900 Hours but she then submitted 900 Hour forms by Supervisors Fabiana Borrego and Monica Santiago Galisa.

MOTION: Ms. Stephanie Petrosky made a motion to approve Ms. Kassahara's application. Ms. Carol Elliott seconded the motion which carried 4/0.

2. Carolina Dadalto Fernandes Rocha (Application by Examination)

Ms. Dadalto Fernandes Rocha was present.

Ms. Carolina Dadalto Fernandes Rocha submitted an Application by Examination. She graduated from Federal University of Espirito Santo in Brazil with a master's degree in Physical Education in March of 2012. Ms. Fernandes also graduated from Federal University of Ouro Preto in Brazil with a bachelor's degree in Nutrition in November 2002. A credential evaluation was received from SPANTRAN Educational Services with a course-by-course evaluation of Ms. Fernandes's undergraduate study at Federal University of Espirito Santo as well as Federal University of Ouro Preto in terms of U.S. courses, semester credit hours and grades. She wants to use her experience in lieu of the 60-hour missing from her 900-hour requirement as defined in 468.509, Part 2 (b)3.

3. Sandra Hector (Application by Examination w/ Temp)

Ms. Hector was present.

Ms. Sandra Hector submitted an Application by Examination. She graduated from London Metropolitan University in London, England with a Bachelor of Science degree with Upper Second Class Honours in Human Nutrition on July 16, 2009. An unofficial copy of her credential evaluation was received from WES reflecting a U.S. Equivalency Summary of a bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited institution. The document is "unofficial" due to Ms. Hector as well as Council staff experiencing hardship in obtaining the official document due to COVID-19. Ms. Hector has requested to use her education and/or experience in lieu of the required 900 supervised hours.

MOTION: Ms. Stephanie Petrosky made a motion to approve Ms. Hector's application. Ms. Carol Elliott seconded the motion which carried 4/0.

4. Anita Calore (Application by Examination)

Ms. Calore was present.

Ms. Calore submitted an Application by Examination. She graduated from Centro Universitario Sao Camilo in Brazil with a bachelor's degree in Nutrition Science in December of 2003. A credential evaluation was received from Josef Silny & Associates, Inc. with a course-by-course evaluation of Ms. Calore's undergraduate study at Sao Camilo University Center in terms of U.S. courses, semester

credit hours and grades. Ms. Calore has provided her 900-hour forms from supervisors in Brazil and Brazilian Nutritionist License.

Mr. Francisco has provided his 900-hour internship declarations from supervisors in Brazil and his Brazilian Nutritionist License.

Both are active with no discipline history.

9. Zulema Rodriguez (Examination with Waiver)

Ms. Rodriguez submitted an Application by Examination with Waiver, certified by CNS. Council staff has pulled license verifications for supervisors, Nadine Mikati and Jennifer Lynn Caceres, both are Certified Dietetics Nutritionist Licensed in Florida. Ms. Rodriguez has provided 900-hours internship and her Certified Nutritionist Specialist certification. She received a Master of Science in Education in Nutrition and Human Performance from the University of Miami in Miami, Florida on May 5, 2019. She received a Bachelor of science in Chemistry from Barry University in Miami Shores, Florida on May 9, 2015.

MOTION: Ms. Stephanie Petrosky made a motion to approve Ms. Rodriguez's application. Ms. Carol Elliott seconded the motion which carried 4/0.

10. Deborah Hutchinson (Examination with Waiver w/ Temp)

Ms. Hutchinson was present.

Ms. Deborah Hutchinson applied by Examination by Endorsement of CNS w/ Temp. in November of 2019. She had requested to waive the 90-day requirement in order to complete her doctorate. She wishes to appear at the August meeting. Ms. Hutchinson was originally scheduled to take the CNS exam on June 7, 2020 and due to COVID-19 the test was postponed. Ms. Hutchinson will be taking the CNS exam on August 04, 2020. A request to Council is being made for approval of her application if warranted contingent on the passing exam score of the CNS Exam. Council can also discuss the option of the temporary license in which she applied is applicable until exam results are obtained. Ms. Hutchinson received a Doctor of Clinical Nutrition degree on April 17, 2020. Ms. Hutchinson received a Master of Science degree from University of Bridgeport in Human Nutrition on December 18, 2016. She has requested to use her education hours earned from her master's degree in Clinical Human Nutrition from University of Bridgeport and the transcripts from Maryland University of Integrative Health where she is received her doctorate in clinical nutrition in lieu of the 900-hour requirement as defined in 468.509, Part X.

The condition is the application for Examination with Waiver w/ Temp is approved contingent that Ms. Hutchinson receives a successful passing examination score from the Certification Board for Nutrition Specialists within twelve months of the filed order. Ms. Linda Rex seconded the motion which carried 4/0.

Dr. Emma Norton is a license Naturopathic Doctor in the State of California. Ms. Matta has provided her 900-hour forms and her Certified Nutritionist Specialist certification. She received a Doctorate of Naturopathic Medicine from the University of Bastyr San Diego, California on June 22, 2019.

12. Monica Medina-Dobbs (Examination with Waiver w/ Temp)

Monica Carolina Medina-Dobbs is applying by Examination with waiver with Temp. Ms. Medina-Dobbs was originally scheduled to take the CNS exam on June 7, 2020 and due to COVID-19 the test was postponed. Ms. Medina-Dobbs will be taking the CNS exam on August 01, 2020 a request to Council is being made for approval of her application if warranted contingent on the passing exam score of the CNS Exam. Council can also discuss the option of the temporary license in which she applied is applicable until exam results are obtained. Council staff has pulled the license verification for her supervisor Sarah Bingham. Ms. Bingham is a certified Dietician Nutritionist in the State of Florida. of Alaska with specialty Designation as Diplomate of the American Board of Chiropractic Internist. Ms. Thomas has provided her 900 Hour forms and her Certified Nutritionist Specialist certification. She received a Master of Science in Human Nutrition and Functional Medicine from the University of Western State in Portland, Oregon on September 22, 2017.

The application for Examination with Waiver is approved contingent upon the following conditions: the applicant shall provide adequate qualification of her supervisor's education and training related to the dietetic and nutrition practice and clarification of her pre- professional experience both to be submitted to council staff and forwarded to council chair for review within 30 days of filed order. Ms. Linda Rex seconded the motion which carried 4/0.

14. Olena May (Examination with Waiver)

Ms. May holds a CNS Certification and is applying by the method that allows wavier of the CDR examination. Council staff has pulled the license verification for her supervisors Sarah Bingham, Linda Fleming and Jan Kielmann. Sarah Bingham is a certified Nutritionist in the State of Florida, Linda Fleming is a certified Nutritionist in the State of Connecticut and Jan Kielmann is a certified Nutritionist in the State of Washington. Ms. May has provided her 900 Hour forms and her Certified Nutritionist Specialist certification. She received a Bachelors in Translation Management from the International Scientific University in Kyiv, Ukraine on June 21, 2008. She received a Master of Science in Human Nutrition from the University of Bridgeport in Bridgeport, Connecticut on August 25, 2019.

15. Tiffany Anne Smith (Application by Endorsement of CDR W/ History)

Ms. Smith must enroll in and successfully complete 10 hours of continuing education specifically addressing the ethics and professionalism in the practice of dietetics and nutrition practice within 30 days of filed order. Ms. Smith must self- report the unlicensed

activity to The Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics and Commission on Dietetics and Registration. Ms. Carol Elliott seconded the motion which carried 4/0.

MOTION: After Discussion, Ms. Stephanie Norris made a motion to approve the amended Health History questions in Rule 64B8-42.001, F.A.C., Licensure by Endorsement and Rule 64B8-42.002, F.A.C., Licensure by Examination in the new application for Dietetics and Nutrition upon removal of the profession of Osteopathic Medicine and the addition of Dietetics and Nutrition on Page 11 of 19 under Physical and Mental Health Disorders Impacting Ability to Practice (Part A) and Page 11 of 19 under Physical and Mental Health Disorders Impacting Ability to Practice (Part B) and Page 11 of 19 Under Substance-Related Disorders Impacting Ability to Practice (Part C) as well as the revision date of the application be updated to 08/2020.
