Authority and Intent

Section 395.4025(2)(a), Florida Statutes, requires the Florida Department of Health (Department) to “prepare an analysis of the Florida trauma system by August 31, 2020, and every 3 years thereafter, using the hospital discharge database described in s. 408.061 for the most current year and the most recent 5 years of population data for the state available from the American Community Survey 5-Year Estimates by the United States Census Bureau.”

Concerning the content, the statute further specifies that the “report must, at a minimum, include all of the following:

- The population growth for each trauma service area and for the state.
- The number of high-risk patients treated at each trauma center within each trauma service area, including pediatric trauma centers.
- The total number of high-risk patients treated at all acute care hospitals, including nontrauma centers, in each trauma service area.
- The percentage of each trauma center’s sufficient volume of trauma patients, as described in subparagraph (3)(d)2., in accordance with the International Classification Injury Severity Score for the trauma center’s designation, inclusive of the additional caseload volume required for those trauma centers with graduate medical education programs.”

Florida Trauma System Assessment

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Definitions, Data Sources, and Methodologies

Section 395.4025, F.S., specifies that the Department “make available all data, formulas, methodologies, calculations, and risk adjustment tools used in preparing the report.”

Accordingly, all materials used to complete this assessment will be posted on the Department’s Trauma System web page at <https://www.floridahealth.gov/licensing-and-regulation/trauma-system/trauma-system-assessment.html>.

These items may also be requested through the Department’s public records request web page at <http://www.floridahealth.gov/about/sunshine-info/public-records-requests/index.html>. The following definitions, data sources, and methodologies were used by the Department to complete this assessment:

Acute Care Hospital is defined as a facility licensed under Chapter 395, F.S., that has the presence of a dedicated Emergency Room Department on the Hospital Emergency Services Inventory list, which is published by the Agency for Health Care Administration (AHCA) in accordance with s. 395.1041(2), F.S. See Appendix F.

Patient Data, as required by the statute, were obtained from the AHCA’s Inpatient Hospital Discharge Data collected pursuant to s. 408.061, F.S. For purposes of this assessment, the 2022 patient data are the most recent year available. Inpatient Hospital Discharge Data may be obtained directly from AHCA. See Appendix D for information about obtaining AHCA inpatient data.

Population Data, as required by the statute, were obtained using the most recent five years of population data available from the *American Community Survey 5-Year Estimates* by the United States Census Bureau. The U.S. Census Bureau population estimates are accessible at the following sites for, respectively, 2018 and 2022: <https://www.census.gov/data/datasets/time-series/demo/popest/2010s-counties-total.html> and <https://www.census.gov/data/datasets/time-series/demo/popest/2020s-counties-total.html>.

Alternatively, population data may be accessed at the U.S. Census site “American Community Survey 5-Year Data (2009-2021)” address: <https://www.census.gov/data/developers/data-sets/acs-5year.html>.

Trauma Service Area Population Growth Rate is defined as the rate of change in the TSA based on the percentage increase or decrease of the total population of all counties in the TSA from year one to year five.

Example Expression:

$$\text{Population Growth} = \frac{[(\text{Total population in year 5}) - (\text{Total population in year 1})]}{\text{Total population in year 1}}$$

Trauma Service Area Population is defined as the cumulative population of all counties in the TSA for the year 2022. See TSA Population Tables in Appendix C.

Survival Risk Ratio (SRR) is defined as the incidence and outcome (mortality) associated with International Classification of Diseases, Tenth Revision Clinical Modification (ICD-10-CM), codes in the range given by S00-T88, “Injury, poisoning and certain other consequences of external causes.”

Example Expression:

$$SSR_D = \frac{Survivors_D}{Patients_D} = 1 - \left(\frac{Died_D}{Patients_D} \right)$$

The calculation includes the principal, as well as the 30 other diagnosis fields, where *D* represents “diagnosis.” Inclusion criteria for inpatient records are as follows: (a) the episode was categorized as either an emergency or a trauma alert, (b) the patient was treated at a facility designated as a trauma center, and (c) the episode involved an initial encounter (excluding subsequent encounters and sequelae). See SRR Calculation Methodology by Etienne E. Pracht, PhD in Appendix E.

The data set used to calculate SRRs included five years (2017-2021) of records for patients ages 16-64, which were obtained from AHCA.

SRRs used to complete this assessment are available on the Department’s Trauma System web page: <https://www.floridahealth.gov/licensing-and-regulation/trauma-system/trauma-system-assessment.html>.

High-Risk Patient is defined by s. 395.4001(4), F.S., as a trauma patient with an International Classification Injury Severity Score (ICISS) of less than 0.85.

International Classification Injury Severity Score (ICISS) is defined as an ICD-based multiplicative prediction model that calculates the likelihood of survival of an injured patient based on the assumption that all injuries contribute to the overall severity. The ICISS score for each injured patient was calculated, using the most recent complete year of the AHCA’s Hospital Discharge Data Set, as the multiplicative product of all the (SRRs) associated with each injury ICD code listed in the patient’s record.

Example Expression for a patient with *N* injuries:

$$ICISS = (SRR \text{ Injury } 1) \times (SRR \text{ Injury } 2) \times \dots \times (SRR \text{ Injury } N)$$

The ICISS definition is based on the definition found in the *Nakahsra S, Yoloka J, Revision of the International Classification of Diseases to include standardized descriptions of multiple injuries and injury severity, Bulletin of the World Health Organization, Volume 89, Number 3, March 2011, pg. 238-240.*

Trauma Center is defined as a Level I, Level II, or pediatric standalone trauma center currently designated by the Florida Department of Health. See Trauma Center List in Appendix C.

Trauma Service Area (TSA) is defined in s. 395.402(1)(a), F.S. See TSA Map in Appendix A.

Graduate Medical Education Programs/ accredited critical care and trauma surgical subspecialty medical resident or fellow (GME) is defined as meeting one of the following:

1. A chief resident or a fourth-year postgraduate resident (PGY-4) or a fifth-year postgraduate resident (PGY-5), whichever is the highest level offered by the trauma center, who is primarily assigned to an Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) General Surgery residency program at the hospital.
2. A chief resident or a PGY-4 or a PGY-5, whichever is the highest level offered by the trauma center affiliated with a United States Department of Defense (DoD) medical training program, who is temporarily assigned to an ACGME General Surgery residency program at the hospital for the purposes of fulfilling the training requirements of the DoD training program.
3. An ACGME, Surgical Critical Care Fellow, who is assigned to a fellowship position sponsored by the hospital.
4. An American College of Surgeons (ACS) and American Association for the Surgery of Trauma (AAST) Acute Care Surgery Fellow, who is assigned to a fellowship position sponsored by the hospital.

Note: Except for DoD trainees, trauma centers are prohibited from declaring a person as a qualifying resident or fellow if he or she takes rotations, provides clinical services, or is otherwise employed by the hospital but is assigned to a qualifying ACGME or AAST program at another hospital.

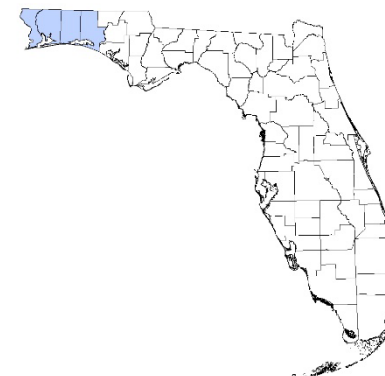
A completed *Attestation of Trauma-Related Graduate Medical Education* received by the Department is provided in Appendix G.

Sufficient Caseload Volume/Minimum Caseload Volume is defined in s. 395.4025(3)(d)2.a-e, F.S., based on population, trauma center status, and number of qualifying trauma surgical subspecialty medical residents or fellows.

Percentage of each trauma center's sufficient volume of trauma patients (Percentage) is calculated by the trauma center's actual volume of "high-risk patients" divided by the volumes set forth by s. 395.4025(3)(d)2.a-e, F.S., based on population, trauma center status, and number of qualifying trauma surgical subspecialty medical residents or fellows.

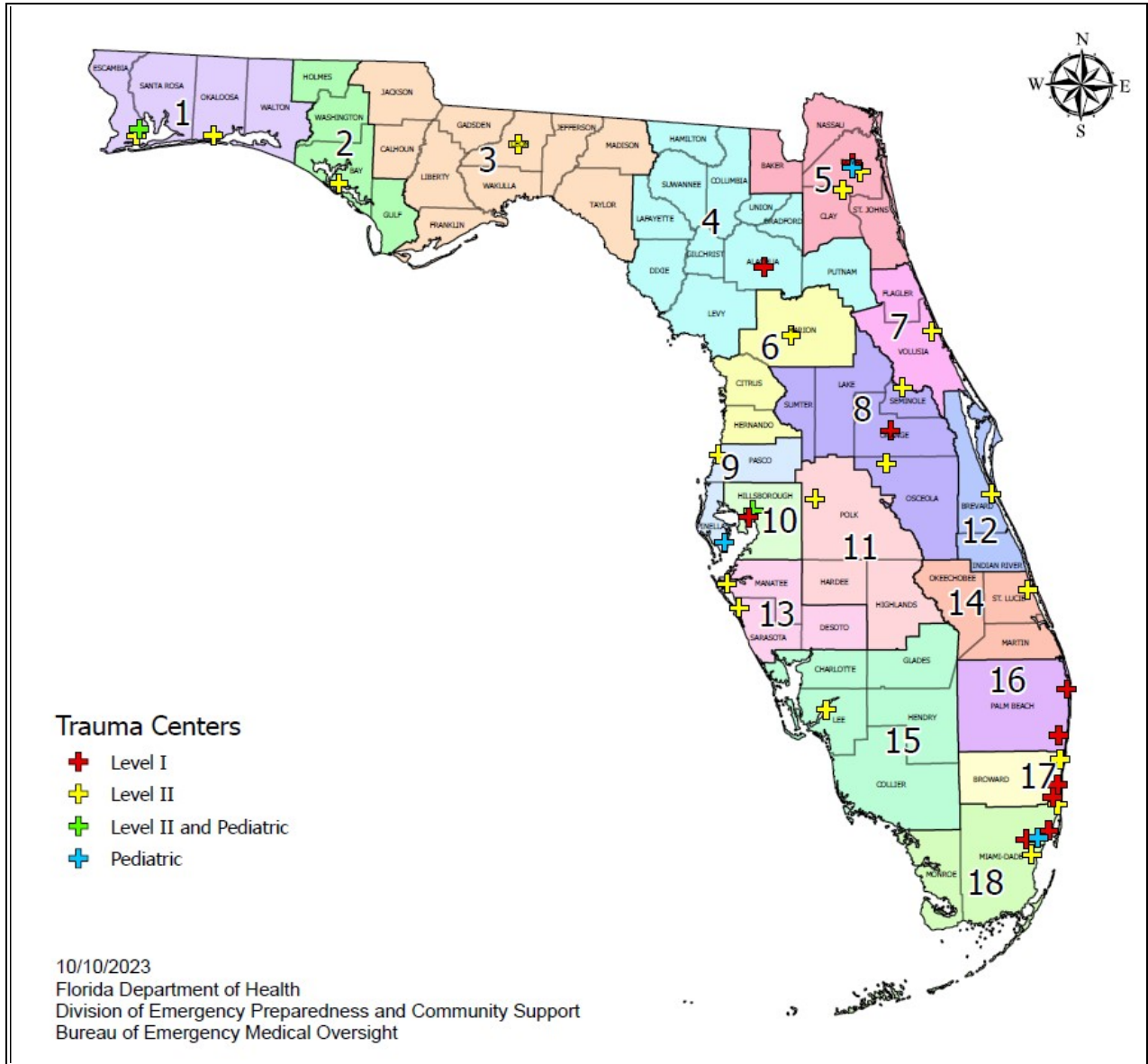

Appendix D: How to obtain the AHCA Data Set

Statement from the AHCA Patient Data Submission Guide on public release of discharge data:

Public Release of Discharge Data

“The Agency for Health Care Administration collects inpatient discharge, outpatient and ambulatory, and emergency room data from acute, short-term psychiatric, long-term psychiatric and comprehensive rehabilitation hospitals in Florida. The data are updated on a quarterly basis, and there are approximately 2.5 million records per year. Each record in the dataset corresponds to an individual inpatient hospital, outpatient, or ER visit. The file has patient-level data and includes information on patient demographics, diagnosis and procedure codes, attending physician, operating or performing physicians, and total gross charges.”

“AHCA releases the inpatient data once 75% of the reporting facilities have certified the accuracy of their data, which is usually accomplished by 130 days after the end of a reporting period. All of the data are typically verified within 180 days of the end of the reporting period, meaning the data set is more complete two months after the initial version is released by AHCA. Discharge data from comprehensive rehabilitation hospitals are certified upon submission.”

Appendix E: SRR Calculation Methodology

The scope of work called for the compilation of survival risk ratios (SRRs) using inpatient records obtained from the Agency for Health Care Administration (AHCA) from five years preceding the analysis year (2017-2021). The analysis year is not included in the SRR calculation to avoid same-year bias in the calculations.

Part 1 called for the compilation of the incidence and outcome (mortality) associated with all ICD10CM codes in the S00-T88, "Injury, poisoning and certain other consequences of external causes." For each diagnosis:

$$SRR_D = \frac{Survivors_D}{Patients_D} = \left(1 - \frac{Died_D}{Patients_D}\right)$$

The calculation will include the principal as well as the 30 other diagnosis fields. Inclusion criteria for inpatient records are as follows: (a) the episode was categorized as either an emergency or a trauma alert, and (b) the patient was treated at a facility designated as a trauma center,¹ and (c) the episode involved an initial encounter (excluding subsequent encounters and sequelae).

Part 2 called for the stratification of the SRRs for three age groups: pediatric (ages 0-15 years), non-elderly adults (ages 16-64), and elderly adults (ages 65 and older). The overall SRR, including all age groups, was compiled under part 1.

Deliverables: The SRRs are recorded in an excel spreadsheet named "FloridaAHCA_2017to2021_SRR.xlsx." The spreadsheet contains five worksheets:

1. Centers: a tally of the number of observations included in the compilation, broken down by year and trauma center.
2. SRRAllAges: contains the incidence, mortality, and SRR for all initial injury diagnoses in the S and T ranges, for all patients regardless of age.
3. SRRPeds: contains the incidence, mortality, and SRR for all initial injury diagnoses in the S and T ranges, for all pediatric patients, age 0 to 15.
4. SRRAdults: contains the incidence, mortality, and SRR for all initial injury diagnoses in the S and T ranges, for all non-elderly adult patients, age 16 to 64.
5. SRRElderly: contains the incidence, mortality, and SRR for all initial injury diagnoses in the S and T ranges, for all elderly patients, age 65 and over.
