Authority and Intent

Section 395.4025 (2)(a), F.S., requires the Florida Department of Health (Department) to prepare an analysis of the state's trauma system by August 31, 2020, and every three years thereafter, using the hospital discharge database described in section 408.061, F.S., for the most current year. In addition, the Department must use the most recent five years of population data for the state available from the United States Census Bureau. The statute directs that the Department's report must, at a minimum, include all of the following:

- The population growth for each trauma service area (TSA) and for the state.
- The number of high-risk patients treated at each trauma center within each TSA, including pediatric trauma centers.
- The total number of high-risk patients treated at all acute care hospitals, including non-trauma centers, in each TSA.
- The percentage of each trauma center's sufficient volume of trauma patients, as described in section 395.4025 (3)(d)2, F.S., in accordance with the International Classification Injury Severity Score (ICISS) for the trauma center's designation, inclusive of the additional caseload volume required for those trauma centers with graduate medical education programs.

Definitions, Data Sources and Methodologies

Pursuant to the statute the Department is required to make available all data, formulas, methodologies, calculations, and risk adjustment tools used in preparing this report.

The following definitions, data sources and methodologies were used by the Department to complete this assessment:

<u>Acute Care Hospital</u>: is defined as a facility licensed under Chapter 395, F.S., that has the presence of a dedicated Emergency Room Department on the Hospital Emergency Services Inventory list, which is published by the Agency for Health Care Administration (AHCA) in accordance with section 395.1041(2), F.S. See Appendix F.

<u>Patient Data</u>: as required by the statute, these data were obtained from the AHCA's Inpatient Hospital Discharge Data collected pursuant to section 408.061, F.S. For purposes of this assessment, the 2019 patient data are the most recent year available. Inpatient Hospital Discharge Data may be obtained by contacting the AHCA. See Appendix D for information about obtaining AHCA inpatient data.

<u>Population Data</u>: as required by the statute these data were obtained using the most recent five years of population data available from the *American Community Survey 5-Year Estimates* by the United States Census Bureau. Population data can be obtained from: <u>https://data.census.gov/cedsci/</u>.

<u>TSA Population Growth Rate</u>: is defined as the rate of change in the TSA based on the percentage increase or decrease of the total population of all counties in the TSA from year one to year five.

Example Expression:

<u>TSA Population</u> is defined as the cumulative population of all counties in the TSA for the year 2019. See TSA population tables in Appendix B.

<u>Survival Risk Ratio</u>: is defined as the incidence and outcome (mortality) associated with all International Classification of Diseases (ICD) 10CM codes in the S00-T88, "Injury, poisoning and certain other consequences of external causes."

Example Expression:

$$SRR_D = (survivors_D / patients_D) = (1 - [died_D / patients_D])$$

The calculation includes the principal, as well as the 30 other diagnosis fields. Inclusion criteria for inpatient records are as follows: (a) the episode was categorized as either an emergency or a trauma alert, and (b) the patient was treated at a facility designated as a trauma center , and (c) the episode involved an initial encounter (excluding subsequent encounters and sequelae). See SRR calculation methodology by Etienne E. Pracht, Ph.D., in Appendix E.

The data set used to calculate SRRs was 2016-2019 records for patients ages 16-64, which were obtained from the AHCA.

<u>*High-Risk Patient:*</u> is defined by section 395.4001(4), F.S., as a trauma patient with an International Classification Injury Severity Score (ICISS) of less than 0.85.

<u>International Classification Injury Severity Score (ICISS)</u>: is defined as an International Classification of Diseases (ICD)-based multiplicative prediction model that calculates the likelihood of survival of an injured patient based on the assumption that all injuries contribute to the overall severity. The Department calculates the ICISS score for each injured patient using the most recent complete year of the AHCA's Hospital Discharge Data Set based upon the multiplicative product of all the Survival Risk Ratios (SRRs) associated with each ICD code listed in the patient's record.

Example Expression:

ICISS= (SRR Injury 1) × (SRR Injury 2) × (SRR Injury 3) × (SRR Injury 4) ...

The ICISS definition is based on the definition found in the "Nakahsra S, Yoloka J, Revision of the International Classification of Diseases to include standardized descriptions of multiple injuries and injury severity, Bulletin of the World Health Organization, Volume 89, Number 3, March 2011, pg. 238-240."

<u>Trauma Center:</u> is defined as a Level I, Level II or pediatric standalone trauma center currently designated by the Florida Department of Health. See Trauma Center List in Appendix C.

<u>Trauma Service Area (TSA)</u>: are defined in section 395.402(1)(a), F.S. See TSA Map in Appendix A.

<u>Graduate Medical Education Programs/ "accredited critical care and trauma surgical subspecialty</u> <u>medical resident or fellow" (GME):</u> is defined as meeting one of the following:

- A chief resident, or a fourth-year postgraduate resident (PGY-4) or a fifth-year postgraduate resident (PGY-5), whichever is the highest level offered by the trauma center, who is primarily assigned to an Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) General Surgery residency program at the hospital.
- 2. A chief resident or a PGY-4 or a PGY-5, whichever is the highest level offered by the trauma center affiliated with a United States Department of Defense (DoD) medical training program who is temporarily assigned to an ACGME General Surgery residency program at the hospital for the purposes of fulfilling the training requirements of the DoD training program.
- 3. An ACGME, Surgical Critical Care Fellow who is assigned to a fellowship position sponsored by the hospital.
- 4. An American College of Surgeons (ACS) and American Association for the Surgery of Trauma (AAST) Acute Care Surgery Fellow who is assigned to a fellowship position sponsored by the hospital.

Note: Except for DoD trainees, trauma centers are prohibited from declaring a person as a qualifying resident or fellow if he or she takes rotations, provides clinical services or is otherwise employed by the hospital but is assigned to a qualifying ACGME or AAST program at another hospital.

<u>Sufficient Caseload Volume/ Minimum Caseload Volume:</u> is defined in section 395.4025(3)(d)2.ae, F.S., based on population, trauma center status and number of qualifying trauma surgical subspecialty medical residents or fellows.

<u>Percentage of each trauma center's sufficient volume of trauma patients (Percentage):</u> is calculated by the trauma center's actual volume of "high-risk patients" divided by the volumes set forth by 395.4025(3)(d)2.a-e, F.S., based on population, trauma center status and number of qualifying trauma surgical subspecialty medical residents or fellows.



Public Release of Discharge Data

The Florida Center's Office of Data Collection and Quality Assurance (DCQA) collects all facility discharge data. Approximately 309 hospitals, 215 Emergency Departments, 550 freestanding ambulatory surgical centers and numerous lithotripsy centers and cardiac catheterization laboratories currently submit quarterly reports to AHCA. A limited set of the discharge data is available to the public once 75% of the reporting facilities have certified the accuracy of their data. Reporting facilities must certify their patient data (the final step of the submission process) within 5 months after the end of the covered quarter. Certification status for all facilities or by individual facility by data type/year/quarter is available at the weblink below. Data catalogs, price lists and data layout and file descriptions by facility type are available at the Florida Center for Health Information and Transparency web address as well:

The scope of work called for the compilation of survival risk ratios (SRRs) using 2016-2019 inpatient records obtained from the Agency for Health Care Administration (AHCA).

Part 1 called for the compilation of the incidence and outcome (mortality) associated with all ICD10CM codes in the S00-T88, "Injury, poisoning and certain other consequences of external causes." For each diagnosis,

 $SRR_D = (survivors_D/patients_D) = (1 - [died_D/patients_D])$ The calculation will include the principal as well as the 30 other diagnosis fields. Inclusion criteria for inpatient records are as follows: (a) the episode was categorized as either an emergency or a trauma alert, and (b) the patient was treated at a facility designated as a trauma center¹, and (c) the episode involved an initial encounter (excluding subsequent encounters and sequelae).

Part 2 called for the stratification of the SRRs for three age groups: pediatric (ages 0-15 years), non-elderly adults (ages 16-64), elderly adults (ages 65 and older). The overall SRR, including all age groups, was compiled under part 1.

Deliverables: The SRRs are recorded in an excel spreadsheet named

"FloridaAHCA_2016to2019_SRR.xlsx." The spreadsheet contains four worksheets:

- 1. Centers a tally of the number of observations included in the compilation, broken down by year and trauma center.
- 2. SRRAllAges contains the incidence, mortality, and SRR for all initial injury diagnoses in the S and T ranges, for all patients regardless of age.
- 3. SRRPeds contains the incidence, mortality, and SRR for all initial injury diagnoses in the S and T ranges, for all pediatric patients, age 0 to 15.
- 4. SRRAdults contains the incidence, mortality, and SRR for all initial injury diagnoses in the S and T ranges, for all non-elderly adult patients, age 16 to 64.
- 5. SRRElderly contains the incidence, mortality, and SRR for all initial injury diagnoses in the S and T ranges, for all elderly patients, age 65 and over.

Notes: The data included 56 observations with missing age. While these observations were included in the pooled data, they were excluded from the individual age compilations.

Dear CEO:

The Department of Health is statutorily required to prepare an analysis of the Florida Trauma System by August 31, 2020, and every three years thereafter. As part of the analysis, the Department must determine the number of "accredited critical care and trauma surgical subspecialty medical resident or fellows" at each hospital that is designated by the Department as a trauma center. (see section 395.4025 (2)(a), Florida Statutes).

Following the recommendations of the Florida Trauma System Advisory Council, the Department defines "accredited critical care and trauma surgical subspecialty medical resident or fellow" as:

- A chief resident, or a fourth-year postgraduate resident (PGY-4) or a fifth-year postgraduate resident (PGY-5), whichever is the highest level offered by the trauma center, who is primarily assigned to an Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) General Surgery residency program at the hospital.
- A chief resident or a PGY-4 or a PGY-5, whichever is the highest level offered by the trauma center affiliated with the educational institution, in the Department of Defense (DoD) medical training program who is temporarily assigned to an Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) General Surgery residency program at the hospital for the purposes of fulfilling the training requirements of the DoD training program.
- An Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME), Surgical Critical Care Fellow who is assigned to a fellowship position sponsored by the hospital.
- An American College of Surgeons (ACS) and American Association for the Surgery of Trauma (AAST) Acute Care Surgery Fellow who is assigned to a fellowship position sponsored by the hospital.

Note: Except for DoD trainees, trauma centers are prohibited from declaring a person as a qualifying resident or fellow if he or she takes rotations, provides clinical services or is otherwise employed by the hospital but is assigned to a qualifying ACGME or AAST program at another hospital.

I received your letter dated July 15, 2020 regarding the Department of Health's plan for preparing an analysis of the Florida Trauma System and the need to determine the number of "accredited critical care and trauma surgical subspecialty medical residents or fellows" at each hospital designated by the Department as a trauma center. I am sending this letter to your attention along with the completed and signed attestation on behalf of Nicklaus Children's Hospital in order to clarify some of the answers to the attestation questions.

Background

Nicklaus Children's Hospital; by virtue of it being a free-standing children's hospital with over 90,000 Pediatric Emergency room visits per year including trauma; sponsors accredited fellowship programs in advanced PGY subsubspecialty training in Pediatric subspecialties linked to the trauma program among other specialties including:

- 1- Pediatric Surgery Fellowship (PGY 6, PGY7) These fellows already completed a General Surgery Residency training
- 2- Pediatric Critical Care Fellowship (PGY 4, PGY5, PGY6)
- 3- Pediatric Cardiac Critical Care Fellowship (PGY 7)
- 4- Pediatric Emergency Medicine Fellowship (PGY 4, PGY 5, PGY6)

General Surgery Residency programs are typically adult-based in adult hospitals with a pediatric component. While Nicklaus Children's Hospital is not the sponsoring institution for a General Surgery residency (Due to adult-focused training). Nicklaus Children's Hospital Sponsors the advanced Pediatric Surgery Fellowship training program while serving as the major participating site for the various General Surgery Residencies in the local area. General Surgery Residents from programs such as: UM/ JMH, Cleveland Clinic of Florida, Mount Sinai Medical Center, and Larkin Hospital complete their Pediatric requirements at Nicklaus Children's Hospital. During their Pediatric block of time at Nicklaus Children's the residents spend 100% of that time in our site.

Since the wording of the attestation questions understandably aims at collecting information related to General Surgery Residency and the number of trainees who are PGY 4 or PGY 5, and since our surgical fellows are PGY6 and PGY7 and beyond, I wanted to attach this letter to clarify the way we answered the attestation questions given the background above


