





Introduction • Closed POD

What is a Closed POD?

- ✓ Point of Dispensing
- ✓ Local DOH activates (city or county)
- Serves a targeted dispensing population
- Lessens the burden on Open PODs



Why become a Closed POD?



- Ease of access to lifesaving medications
- Quick dispensing of medications to the targeted dispensing population
- Enhanced continuity of operations

What is anthrax?

- ✓ A serious disease,caused bybacteria
- ✓ When anthrax is inhaled it is much more serious
- ✓ Not communicable from person to person



How is anthrax treated?



- ✓ Antibiotics to
 100% of the
 population within
 48 hours of
 exposure
 - Ciprofloxacin
 - Doxycycline

What's the Closed POD goal?

Our goal is to quickly get medication to the dispensing population to prevent them from getting sick from possible exposure to anthrax





Medication

Strategic National Stockpile (SNS)


- ✓ National repository of medications and medical supplies to be used for emergency situations
- ✓ Within 12 hours, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) can deliver a large shipment from the SNS




Incident Timeline




✓ State and local health departments have plans in place to receive medication shipments from the SNS and break them down into smaller quantities to distribute to Open and Closed PODs





Closed POD Process Overview





Closed POD Roles • An Incident Command System

Incident Command System

Incident Commander (Local DOH)

Has overall responsibility for the incident and sets objectives

Operations Branch (Local DOH)

Develops the tactical organization and directs all resources to carry out the Incident Action Plan

SNS Branch (Local DOH)

Coordinates the receipt and distribution of SNS pharmaceuticals and medical supplies

Closed PODs (Your Hotel)

Serve as a point of dispensing to their targeted dispensing population as part of the DOH's medical countermeasure response

- Crisis management tool
- Establishes a clear chain of command
- ✓ Planned hierarchy
- Directs all communications through a defined chain of command

Incident Command System Roles

PRIMARY COORDINATOR

- Security Coordinator
- Human Resources
 Coordinator
- LogisticsCoordinator
- Business Continuity Coordinator
- AssociateDispensingCoordinator

SECURITY COORDINATOR

- Security
- Medication Receipt
- Queue Control

BACKUP COORDINATOR

 Serves in the event the Primary Coordinator is unable to serve

HUMAN RESOURCES COODINATOR

- Greeter
- Screener
- Medication Dispenser
- Exit Monitor

Associate Dispensing Coordinator


BUSINESS CONTINUITY COODINATOR




Closed POD Organization Chart
