



## 2010 Hearing Screen Data

Florida screened **206,463** babies for hearing!



**3,469 (1.61 %)** hearing screens were not reported to the Newborn Screening Program

**205,289 (95.42%)** babies passed their initial hearing screen, **1,695 (0.79%)** with

**1,174 (0.55 %)** remain in refer\*\* status out of 5212 babies who did not pass their initial hearing screen

**4,951 (2.30 %)** babies were not screened for the following reasons:

- Parent Refused: 909
- NICU: 2,947
- Deceased: 0
- Missed: 336
- Missing Result: 217
- Transferred: 166
- Other: 349
- Previously Screened: 24

\*\*Refer: did not pass hearing screen and require further testing
