What is a tabletop exercise?

- Discuss a hypothetical emergency situation
 Talk through plans and
 - potential concerns
 - Identify gaps
 - Clarify roles
 - Plan for/mitigate risk
- Not a test
- Springboard for further planning and practice (functional exercise)



Tabletop Guidelines



- Facilitator sets the scene.
- Participants immerse themselves as if the scenario were truly happening.
- Everyone is free to contribute!
- Participants respond to the situation.
- Evaluators use an evaluation form to make notes, provide feedback, and identify areas to improve.

Tabletop Goal



To practice the Closed POD Plan, increase the level of confidence enacting the plan, discover and remedy any potential gaps in plan.





Unscheduled "pesticides" spread...



Investigators discover that a fake Parks and Recreation maintenance vehicle spread unscheduled "pesticides" throughout the city.

Traces of anthrax...

A routine reading of a biosensor showed traces of anthrax.



Anthrax confirmed...

Authorities confirm the substance is anthrax.



Public health emergency declared!



The Department of Health declares a public health emergency and requests Strategic National Stockpile countermeasures.

Local DOH makes the decision...

The local DOH decides to engage the Open and Closed PODs to distribute lifesaving medication.

Department of Health activates PODs...

Both Open and Closed PODs are asked to activate.

Hi Kevin, its Alex from the DOH. We have a public health emergency and request activation of your Closed POD. Good luck!

The Event Unfolds

Medication arrives in your city...

The medication has been delivered to your city.



The Event Unfolds



Medication is on its way...

The hotel is notified that medication delivery will be made by 10:00 am. Kevin, I've just gotten confirmation that your property will receive medication by 10:00 am. Is your security team ready?

The Event Unfolds

The emergency is all over the news...

The media has begun to cover the story non-stop, including information about Open PODs.

Command Team in place...

By 8:00 am your Command Team is assembled and briefed.



Volunteers are ready ...



Hotel volunteers have received their assignments and their Command Briefings.

Medication arrives...

The medication is delivered on schedule at 10:00 am.



The Closed POD opens!

The Event Winds Down



POD recipients are served...

Dispensing has scaled-back. Coordinators report that all recipients have received medication.



The Event Winds Down



POD is ready to stand-down...

Alex, my Command Team reports that all our recipients have been served. We are ready to stand-down.

The Primary Coordinator requests permission to stand-down.

The Event Winds Down



DOH makes the call.

The DOH grants permission for the property to stand-down.

Thanks for the report Kevin. Your property has permission to stand-down. And, by the way, your team did a great job!
