


State ESF8 Table of Organization and Staffing Roster

Organizational Structure: The State ESF8 incident management structure is designed to be scalable to manage public health and medical components of an incident. The Operations Section has been added to manage state-level field operations when warranted. The Operations Section can be expanded or contracted based on the type of incident and the incident objectives. It is not designed to be a one-size-fits-all Section.



Staff Assignments: The staff assignment methodology for State ESF8 has changed to designate a primary and alternate for Command Staff, Section Coordinators and Unit Leaders. A pool of staff for the specialists positions will be identified that may be used for those roles. This staff assignment list replaces the previous 3-deep roster.
