# PHEP CP Measures: How to Apply

- ❑ Facilitate a collaborative planning meeting with LHDs at the start of the budget period



## **PHEP CP Measures: How to Apply**

- ❑ **Possible objectives for the planning meeting:**
  - **Review existing Jurisdictional Risk Assessments (JRA) to plan for the response and recovery of hazards**
  - **Support LHDs in identifying jurisdictionally appropriate key organizations across all 11 community sectors to engage in:**
    - Reviewing JRAs
    - Planning the response and recovery related to identified hazards
    - Participating in exercises (including workshops, tabletops, drills, and higher level exercises)

## **PHEP CP Measures: How to Apply**

- ❑ Only LHD data from counties located in the pre-identified sample need to be reported to CDC**
- ❑ If multiple LHDs are located in one sampled county, only report the largest LHD's data**
- ❑ Awardees can request substitutions of counties with their project officers, or may report regional instead of county data (but it must include a sampled county)**
- ❑ Documentation supporting LHD engagement of key organizations in preparedness activities (*reviewing JRAs, planning meetings, exercises*) may be requested by CDC as verification of reported data**

## **PHEP CP Measures: Monitoring**

- ❑ **During the 5 year cooperative agreement, the Division of State and Local Readiness will be monitoring for the following:**
  - **Ensuring data are reported from sampled counties**
  - **Alignment of organizations to sectors**
  - **Rapidly increasing or decreasing numbers of organizations (identified, engaged with, etc.)**
  - **Missing data**
  - **Documentation to support / verify reported data**

## **PHEP CP Measures: Monitoring (cont.)**

- ❑ Relation of performance to funding amounts allocated towards the Community Preparedness Capability**
- ❑ Extremely high or low medians (PHEP 1.1, 1.2, 1.4)**
- ❑ Stagnating or decreasing medians or proportion (PHEP 1.3) across multiple budget periods**
- ❑ Consistency between qualitative and quantitative data**
