PHEP 13.1: Disease Reporting

- ❑ **Measure:** Proportion of reports of selected reportable diseases received by a public health agency within the awardee-required timeframe

PHEP 13.2: Disease Control

- ❑ **Measure:** Proportion of reports of selected reportable diseases for which initial public health control measure(s) were initiated within the appropriate timeframe

PHEP Surveillance PMs: How to Apply

Facilitate a collaborative planning meeting with LHDs at the start of the budget period



PHEP Surveillance Measure 13.1: How to Apply this Measure

Key items to emphasize:

- ❑ Required timeframes in which providers and labs are supposed to report these diseases are regulated by the state.**
- ❑ Appropriate “start time” for each of the six reportable diseases as the selected start times will need to be used by all participating health departments throughout the budget period.**
- ❑ “Stop time” is always the date of first report to a public health agency (e.g., local, county, regional, or state).**
- ❑ Some of the case event date types may not make sense for a particular disease in practice.**

PHEP Surveillance Measure 13.2: How to Apply this Measure

Key items to emphasize:

- ❑ CDC has determined the timeframes within which a health department needs to initiate a control measure for the six selected diseases.**
- ❑ Examples of appropriate control measures for each of the six selected diseases, are all identified in Appendix D of the PHEP BP1 performance measures guidance**
- ❑ Though some health departments may choose to initiate a control measure for suspected cases, waiting until a case is confirmed to initiate a control measure still meets the intent of the performance measure**

PHEP Surveillance Measures 13.1 and 13.2: Monitoring

- ❑ **During the five-year cooperative agreement, the Division of State and Local Readiness will monitor the following:**
 - **Ensuring data are reported from sampled counties**
 - **Missing data**
 - **Documentation to support / verify reported data**
 - **Very low or very high proportions**
 - **Consistency between qualitative and quantitative data**

PHEP Surveillance Measures 13.1 and 13.2: Monitoring (cont.)

- ❑ **During the five-year cooperative agreement, the Division of State and Local Readiness will monitor the following:**
 - **Same case event date type selected for all six diseases (PHEP 13.1)**
 - **Case event date type selected conflicts with clinical practice norms for that disease (PHEP 13.1)**
 - **Low proportions coupled with choosing to wait until confirmation to initiate control measures (PHEP 13.2)**
