Current Status	<p>Much discussion regarding resources that are currently available and the fact that few communities if any, can meet needs of interstate. Most of existing material within children's hospitals in FL is designed to respond to local emergencies</p> <p>Dr. Mulligan shared that Texas developed a large document to address all needs of people using shelters (created and released May 2009) She states that there is no formal coordination for critical care in our state</p> <p>Dr. Northup brought to our attention the reminder that we can quickly overwhelm our existing resources; he states we need a database to work with other states regarding licensure and certifications (many volunteers from other states may come to assist)</p> <p>Dr. Northup also posing question of how to disseminate information regarding resource acquisition. He reminds us that making linkages before the event is essential.</p>	<p>Dr. Mulligan to send additional resources to Belinda; Belinda will re-send the request to Dr. Mulligan. Each hospital has plans in place. Belinda to then send to group for review</p> <p>Bonnie agreed to research and disseminate MRC, SERVFL and ESARVP information. Resources sent to committee on 9/13/11.</p> <p>Dr. Northup agreed to disseminate information regarding MRC in ground rounds.</p>
