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Preface

The Florida Division of Emergency Management (FDEM) is responsible for developing and maintaining the state of Florida Multi-Year Training and Exercise Plan (MYTEP). The state of Florida's MYTEP document represents all domestic security interdisciplinary training and exercise goals and projected schedules for the state and is updated annually. The Florida Department of Health's (FDOH), Bureau of Preparedness and Response (BPR), uses a capability-based approach in relation to the preparedness cycle. Preparedness is a continuous cycle of planning, organizing, training, equipping, exercising, evaluating, and taking corrective action, in an effort to ensure effective coordination during incident response.

FDEM uses a standard collection process that allows for input from both county and state stakeholders, including the Department of Health. The state of Florida's MYTEP provides a roadmap for Florida to accomplish priorities described in Florida's Domestic Security Strategic Plan. Each state priority is linked to a corresponding national priority and, if applicable, an improvement plan. The priority is further linked to associated federal capabilities, as well as training and exercises to help jurisdictions achieve those capabilities.

The Department of Health's Public Health and Health Care Preparedness (PHHP) MYTEP is one of several inputs into the state of Florida's MYTEP. The document is updated annually, follows a similar collection process to that used by FDEM, and aligns to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) *Public Health Preparedness Capabilities: National Standards for State and Local Planning*, and the 2017-2022 Health Care Preparedness and Response Capabilities, Office of the Assistant Secretary for Preparedness and Response (ASPR). The PHHP MYTEP is published and submitted to FDEM for inclusion in the state of Florida MYTEP. The PHHP MYTEP also provides a framework for training and exercise priorities to meet goals, objectives, and strategies in the Department's strategic plan.

The goal of Florida's PHHP is to help prevent and/or minimize illness, injury, and loss of life to Floridians and visitors due to manmade or natural disasters, or other emergencies. The Department achieves this goal through developing and sustaining critical capabilities which enhance the ability of Florida's public health and health care system to prevent, respond to, and recover from all types of hazards. Having a viable public health and health care system is part of an integrated domestic security and emergency management system in Florida.

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Points of Contact (POCs)

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Purpose

The purpose of the 2020-2022 PHHP MYTEP is to provide training and exercise priorities and a roadmap to meet strategies to support the following national and state standards:

- **CDC Public Health Preparedness Capabilities: National Standards for State and Local Planning (March 2011)**
- **ASPR Health Care Preparedness Capabilities, 2017-2022 Health Care Preparedness and Response Capabilities (November 2016)**
- **After Action Report/Improvement Plan (AAR/IP) data from Florida statewide exercises and real-world emergency incidents and events**
- **The Department's Appendix to the State's Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan (CEMP)**
- **FDOH Strategic Priorities for Preparedness Activities, July 2017 – June 2022**

Developing and sustaining public health and health care capabilities enhances BPRs ability to prevent, respond to, and recover from disasters and emergencies of all types. In this way, the Department ensures coordination across the spectrum of capabilities, which allows for a resilient, flexible, and adaptable public health and health care preparedness system.

The PHHP MYTEP covers training and exercise priorities that are both common across the entire state and jurisdictionally specific. In addition, the public health and health care community is encouraged to participate in their county emergency management MYTEP process, leverage their local Threat and Hazard Identification and Risk Assessment (THIRA) and Florida Public Health Risk Assessment Tool (FPHRAT), and After-Action Plans (AAR) when addressing gaps. This ensures their community priorities are addressed.

Each year, county health departments (CHDs), and health care coalitions (HCCs) strive to achieve MYTEP goals. MYTEP priorities listed in the 2020-2022 templates and calendars are guidelines to reach the targets identified in local strategies as well as in the *FDOH Strategic Priorities for Preparedness Activities, July 2017 – June 2022*.

The FDEM's annual Statewide Hurricane Functional Exercise (HurrEx) provides a unique opportunity for all Department of Health programs with response or support responsibilities to test capabilities with state Emergency Support Function 8 (ESF-8), HCCs, and local partners.

The Department uses the Homeland Security Exercise and Evaluation Program (HSEEP), as the standard for exercise management. Adherence to the guidance presented in the HSEEP methodology ensures exercise programs conform to established best practices and helps provide unity and consistency in exercises for all levels of government and non-governmental partners.



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Hazard Focus Areas

The Department’s Preparedness Strategic Planning Oversight Team (SPOT) identified five (5) hazard types as the priority focus areas for alignment of preparedness activities (shown below).

During the next five-year grant funding period, work effort should be aligned with and in support of building capability to respond to these specific hazard types. Additionally, preparedness efforts will be measured per these hazard types to determine if the residual risk to these hazards decreases as capability and resources increase.

Hazard Name	Definition
Biological Disease Outbreak*	<p>The occurrence of a larger number of cases of an illness or syndrome than expected in a certain location during a certain (usually short) timeframe. This definition also includes those biological agents found in the environment and/or diagnosed in animals. Biological disease outbreaks include zoonotic disease(s) and/or an increase in the population of disease-carrying species that have the potential for transmission to humans, including vectors of vector-borne illnesses.</p> <p>* This hazard serves as an overarching category for other hazards with similar public health and medical response activities to include Biological Terrorism – Communicable, Biological Terrorism - Non-Communicable and Pandemic Influenza. Biological Disease Outbreak will be the hazard measured as a proxy for all these hazard types.</p>
Conventional Terrorism	<p>The unlawful use of force and violence against persons or property to intimidate or coerce a government, the civilian population, or any segment thereof, in furtherance of political and/or social objectives. May also include attempted or suspected terrorist intentions that have been successfully thwarted through investigative activity. For the purposes of this analysis, conventional terrorism includes all terrorism except agricultural, biological, chemical, or radiological terrorism which are covered in other hazards in this analysis.</p>
Hazard Name	Definition
Hurricane/Tropical Storm* / Severe Weather	<p>A low-pressure area of closed circulation winds that originates over tropical waters. When sustained wind speeds exceed 39 mph they are called tropical storms, when wind speeds exceed 74 mph they are called hurricanes.</p> <p>* This specific hazard serves as an overarching category for other hazards with similar public health and medical response activities to include Storm Surge. Hurricane/Tropical Storm will be the hazard measured as a proxy for both hazard types.</p>



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	Severe weather refers to any dangerous meteorological phenomena with the potential to cause damage, loss of power, serious social disruption, or loss of human life. Types of severe weather phenomena vary, depending on the latitude, altitude, topography, and atmospheric conditions.
Hazard Name	Definition
Mass Casualty Incidents	An incident that generates a sufficiently large number of casualties, whereby the available health care resources or their management systems are severely challenged or unable to meet the health care needs of the affected population.
Mass Population Surge	The population of an area is increased due to a migration/relocation of another community.

Measuring Improvement

The BPR has built the Florida Public Health Risk Assessment Tool (FPHRAT) to measure progress, identify gaps and re-assess risk overtime. The residual risk score generated by the FPHRAT is the composite score that best indicates the impact building capabilities and increasing resources over time has on reducing the consequences a certain hazard will have on the public health and medical system, if it should occur. Residual risk scores incorporate both pre-populated information and information provided by jurisdictions. The residual risk score combined the mitigation factors present in jurisdictions and is represented by the capabilities and resources scores, community resilience, and critical infrastructure index. Residual Risk = (Hazard Probability * Severity of Consequences) / Mitigation



Public Health and Health Care Preparedness Program Training and Exercise Priorities

Due to recent storm activities in the state of Florida, a trending gap in the special needs sheltering (SpNS) capability was identified. Lessons learned from Hurricane Irma, Category 4, August 2017, helped address training needs in this area so that when Hurricane Michael, Category 5, October 2018 hit, the Department was better prepared to send trained staff to support SpNS shelters.

A Training and Exercise Planning Workshop (TEPW) was conducted by BPR TE&E staff on January 16, 2019. Local-level public health and health care system input was collected and consolidated by county health department and health care coalition representatives and presented at the TEPW. In addition, a state-level perspective was provided regarding the gaps in capabilities that may be addressed by trainings and exercises. Each participant provided inputs on the Training Plan, Exercise Plan and the 2020-2022 Training and Exercise calendars.

Prior to the TEPW, training and exercise staff were assigned to regional county health department point of contacts and health care coalition leads to help with any questions in completing the training and exercise templates and calendars. There were three (3) MGT-418 *Readiness: Training Identification Preparedness Planning* (RTIPP) courses offered during 2018 to assist stakeholders in identifying training and exercise gaps. RTIPP is a Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) course offered in partnership with the FDEM and National Center for Biomedical Research and Training (NCBRT) at Louisiana State University (LSU). RTIPP introduces the concept of preparedness planning through the identification of gaps and goals.

The RTIPP framework builds a bridge between planning and training to identify those gaps and goals, as well as priorities, audience, frequency of training, and sources for the training. The result is an extensive list of trainings and courses for local public health and health care partners, both planned for and requested by their members. Health care coalition representatives, capability leads, BPR managers and seven (7) CHD representatives, one from each of Florida's Regional Domestic Security Task Force regions, and partners attended the TEPW. The information collected during the TEPW, along with a list of participants, may be found in *Appendix A: Training and Exercise Planning Workshop (TEPW) Participants*.

Hospital Preparedness Program (HPP) and Public Health Emergency Preparedness (PHEP) awardees and each HCC, as part of a coordinated statewide effort, must conduct a joint statewide exercise (functional or full-scale) once during the project period to test progress toward achieving the capabilities outlined in the 2017-2022 Health Care Preparedness and Response Capabilities and the Public Health Preparedness Capabilities: National Standards for State and Local Planning, and in collaboration with cross-border metropolitan statistical area (MSA)/Cities Readiness Initiative (CRI) regions.

2019 Training and Exercise Planning Workshop Summary and Priorities

The FDOH BPR Training and Exercise (T&E) Section welcomed representatives from the BPR, 10 HCC, 7 CHD representatives from all regions, representatives from the Florida Division of Emergency Management Training and Exercise (T&E) Unit, Florida Hospital Association, and bureau capability leads. The purpose of the TEPW was to determine training and exercise gaps, identify priorities and discuss inputs to the 2020-2022 MYTEP.

The 2019 TEPW featured a Workshop on Wednesday, January 16. Instructors, from the Texas A&M Engineering Extension Service (TEEX) facilitated the *MGT-312 Senior Officials Workshop for All-Hazards Preparedness*. The workshop provided an opportunity for participants from across the state to share strategies and coordinate plans for emergency preparedness and response. The setting also enhanced coordination among jurisdiction officials, as well as shared proven strategies and practices, and apply lessons-learned from past incidents.

The 2019 TEPW Process

The BPR T&E staff compiled the group's preliminary work into one document for discussion during the workshop. No CHD, capability or HCC is expected to meet every identified training or exercise priority.

The training and exercise presentations and discussions were conducted separately. The format allowed participants an opportunity to better understand the resources available and provided for small group discussions to promote collaboration.

During small group discussions, HCC representatives, bureau capability leads and regional CHD representatives, were encouraged to collaborate within their own and neighboring regions to address training and exercise gaps and needs. Groups selected the top three (3) training and table top exercise for the BPR, T&E Section to develop during the next grant cycle.

During the TEPW in January 2019, participants were also given an opportunity to review courses offered in the FDEM SERT-TRAC's online Learning Management System, the National Preparedness Course Catalog by the National Domestic Preparedness Consortium (NDPC), and TRAIN FL's online Learning Management System. Stations were set up and equipped with computers and staffed by representatives familiar with course offerings to assist participants in finding appropriate courses to fill their gaps.



Training Development Priorities

For the training portion of the workshop groups were asked to rank their top three priority for trainings needed to fill gaps. The top trainings are listed below with their associated capability and priority. The BPR, T&E Section will develop these during the next grant cycle.

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


