## Immunization Requirements for Childcare

Prior to entry into Florida childcare facilities and family daycare homes, each child shall have a *Florida Certification of Immunization* (Form DH 680) on file documenting age-appropriate immunizations of the following vaccines:

- Pneumococcal conjugate vaccine (PCV13)\*
- Diphtheria-tetanus-pertussis (DTaP) vaccine
- Polio vaccine (IPV)
- Measles-mumps-rubella (MMR) vaccine
- Varicella vaccine (chickenpox)\*\*
- *Haemophilus influenzae* type b (Hib) vaccine
- Hepatitis B (Hep B)

\* Effective January 1, 2012, PCV required for children 2-59 months.

\*\*Varicella vaccine is not required if there is a history of varicella disease documented by the health care provider.
