


# Every Woman, Every Time



## It is the law!

Rule 64D-3.042, Florida Administrative Code, requires health care providers to test all pregnant women during every pregnancy for hepatitis B surface antigen (HBsAg) at their initial visit and again at 28 to 32 weeks. If positive, report the results to your local county health department.
