December Vaccine Shipping and Ordering

For optimal processing and to ensure receipt of VFC Program vaccines during the month of December, the VFC Program is recommending providers that normally order during the second half of December submit orders *no later than December 8, 2017*. Ordering schedules for providers that order in the first half of the month should also place their order by December 8th.

McKesson will stop filling orders at 12:00pm on December 13, 2017. Vaccine will be shipped up to December 18, 2017, but will *not* be shipped from December 19, 2017-January 1, 2018. Regular vaccine shipments will resume on January 2, 2018.

Some offices may be closed or have limited office hours, so please make certain someone will be available to receive the vaccine shipment when you place your order.
