SANFORD—The Florida Department of Health in Seminole County (DOH-Seminole) invites you to join the Take a Loved One to the Doctor Month campaign. This campaign aims to improve the health of all Floridians by encouraging prevention and early detection.

The Department of Health in Seminole County will be hosting a special event for the community Thursday September 26th from 1:00 - 4:00pm at their main clinic located at 400 W. Airport Boulevard in Sanford. Participants will receive free health screenings including STD, cholesterol, blood pressure, hemoglobin, glucose as well as connect with local health resources. There will be door prizes and raffles throughout the afternoon. The event is hosted in partnership with various community agencies, hospitals and private health providers.

“This event is an opportunity to create awareness on the importance of visiting a physician, not only when sick but as a way to prevent many chronic diseases.
