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Below is a brief summary of the changes. Please refer to the actual text for details.

*PART I: Definition of "principal activity" added and "special nuclear material" corrected (Note: your copy may have already corrected the definition of "special nuclear material").

PART II: Changes made to fees, mailing address, department notification for RSO changes, and time frames stated for facility decommissioning.

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- PART III: Respiratory protection medical fitness requirement is relaxed. Transfer for disposal and manifest requirements added for radioactive materials going to a licensed low level radioactive waste disposal facility. New attachment added to support waste manifest requirements. Notification to individuals of occupational or member of the public exposures are required if the department must be notified.
- PART IV: Industrial radiography equipment tests are indicated.
- PART V: Requirements for medical physicists who establish and maintain quality control programs at mammography facilities and the removal of special regulations for older fluoroscopes.
- PART VI: Use of Sm-153 as a calibration standard has been added.
- PART IX: Instruction to workers requirement has been revised; instruction to individuals who in the course of employment may receive 100 milirem per year in both normal and abnormal situations.
- PART XV: Mailing address change.
