Rural areas shown in purplish pink consists of the counties: Walton, Holmes, Washington, Jackson, Calhoun, Gulf, Franklin, Liberty, Gadsden, Wakulla, Jefferson, Madison, Taylor, Hamilton, Suwannee, Lafayette, Dixie, Columbia, Gilchrist, Levy, Baker, Union, Bradford, Hardee, DeSoto, Highlands, Okeechobee, Glades, Hendry and Monroe.

Urban areas shown in green consists of the counties: Escambia, Santa Rosa, Okaloosa, Bay, Leon, Nassau, Duval, Clay, St. Johns, Alachua, Putnam, Flagler, Volusia, Marion, Citrus, Hernando, Pasco, Hillsborough, Pinellas, Manatee, Sarasota, Charlotte, Lee, Collier, Sumter, Lake, Polk, Seminole, Orange, Osceola, Brevard, Indian River, St. Lucie, Martin, Palm Beach, Broward, and Dade.

A rural county is defined as having a total population\* of 100,000 or fewer people and density of less than 100 people per square mile (s.401.107(5), FS.).
