Dr. Cottler’s research is focused on addiction, its comorbidity with other disorders, its consequences, and community-based efforts. Included in this work has been the development of widely used interviews for substance use and other psychiatric disorders, nosological issues of addictions, and peer-delivered interventions to reduce high-risk behaviors. Recent work has focused on prescription drugs, impaired physicians, and community-based efforts, along with international research in Taiwan, Australia, India and Afghanistan. In addition, she has served in many other capacities, including Director of the Master Psychiatric Epidemiology program at Washington University, former Director of a 28-year NIMH Post-Doctoral Training Program in Epidemiology and Biostatistics and Director of a NIDA T32 Training Program in comorbidity and Biostatistics.
