## **Clarification to Request for Letter of Intent**

Organizations may submit only one Letter of Intent.

Organizations will only be permitted to be the lead on one application, but may be collaborators on applications submitted by other organizations.

If the organization intends to submit one or more applications where the organization is collaborating with another organization, we request that this be indicated in the Letter of Intent.

If the organization has not decided on the subject area for the grant application(s) yet, the Letter of Intent can describe the range of topics.

However, a letter of intent is not required, is not binding, and does not enter into the review of a subsequent application, the information it contains allows Department of Health staff to estimate the potential review workload and plan for the review.
