Dr. Alberto Caban-Martinez is a board-certified osteopathic physician, occupational epidemiologist and Assistant Professor of Public Health Sciences at the University of Miami, Miller School of Medicine and the Sylvester Comprehensive Cancer Center. In May 2011, he completed both the Osteopathic Medicine program at Nova Southeastern University College of Osteopathic Medicine as well as the doctoral epidemiology program at the University of Miami. He completed a postdoctoral fellowship in clinical orthopedics and occupational medicine at the Harvard School of Public Health in 2014. His research primarily examines cancer burden and risk factors in the first responder workforce. He has articles published in the American Journal of Public Health, Preventive Medicine, the Journal of Occupational and Environmental Medicine and Neuropharmacology. He has published over 106 peer reviewed publications and presented over 168 scientific presentations on a wide range of occupational health and safety topics. He serves as deputy director of the Sylvester Firefighter Cancer Initiative and Principal Investigator of the American Cancer Society funded “Determining Occupational Uncertainty in Sources and Exposures” Firefighter Gear Pilot Study.
