Dr. Miguez is a distinguished figure in her field with over 20 years of research experience with HIV-infected individuals. In addition to her research Dr. Miguez is a professor at Florida International University and a professor emeritus at the University of Miami, Department of Psychiatry. She currently serves as the director of Health Behavior and Policy Initiative while also being a professor in the School of Integrated Science and Humanity (SISH).
