Emma Spencer's Presentation

Understanding HIV-1 Antiretroviral (ARV) drug resistance in Florida's population is essential for the development of local and statewide treatment and prevention programs. Determining baseline drug resistance using nucleotide genotyping on treatment-naïve patients is recommended to ascertain appropriate therapies to use in the presence of ARV resistance. Research findings from this study will be presented.

Data captured through a health department administered health assessment were used to determine the health status of refugees upon arrival in Florida from 2013-15. Research findings from this assessment will be presented.
