







Florida Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (PDMP) Monthly Report

E-FORCSE. PDMPs gather information on controlled substance dispensations and use. For more information, click <u>here</u>.




- o The red line represents the number of fentanyl prescriptions.
- o The percentages indicated the percent change from the previous year.




Age-Adjusted Opioid Prescription Rate by County, Florida May, 2023

acetaminophen with codeine phosphate, acetaminophen/caffeine/dihydrocodeine bitartrate, acetaminophen/codeine phosphate, acetaminophen/hydrocodone bitartrate, acetaminophen/hydrocodone bitartrate, acetaminophen/oxycodone HCl, acetaminophen/oxycodone HCl, acetaminophen/tramadol HCl, aspirin/caffeine/dihydrocodeine bitartrate, buprenorphine, buprenorphine HCl, buprenorphine HCl/naloxone HCl, buprenorphine HCl, butalbital/acetaminophen/caffeine/codeine phosphate, butorphanol tartrate, carisoprodol/aspirin/codeine phosphate, codeine phosphate/butalbital/aspirin/caffeine, codeine sulfate, fentanyl, fentanyl citrate, hydrocodone bitartrate, hydrocodone bitartrate/acetaminophen, hydrocodone/ibuprofen, hydromorphone HCl, ibuprofen/oxycodone HCl, levorphanol tartrate, meperidine HCl, methadone HCl, morphine sulfate, morphine sulfate/naltrexone HCl, opium/belladonna alkaloids, oxycodone HCl, oxycodone HCl/acetaminophen, oxycodone HCl/aspirin, oxycodone HCI/oxycodone terephthalate/aspirin, oxycodone HCI, oxycodone myristate, oxymorphone HCl, pentazocine HCl/naloxone HCl, tapentadol HCl, tramadol HCl, tramadol HCI/acetaminophen, tramadol HCI.

Benzodiazepines Include:

alprazolam, amitriptyline HCI/chlordiazepoxide, chlordiazepoxide HCl, chlordiazepoxide/clidinium bromide, clobazam, clonazepam, clonazepam, clorazepate dipotassium, diazepam, estazolam, flurazepam HCl, lorazepam, oxazepam, quazepam, temazepam, triazolam.

Stimulants Include:

amphetamine, amphetamine sulfate, dexmethylphenidate HCl, dextroamphetamine sulf-saccharate/amphetamine sulf-aspartate, dextroamphetamine sulfate, lisdexamfetamine dimesylate, methylphenidate, methylphenidate HCl.
