



## E-FORCSE MEANINGFUL USE ATTESTATION— Submission of Dispensing Information

Florida's Prescription Drug Monitoring Program, E-FORCSE, maintained by the Florida Department of Health (FDOH) meets the definition of a specialized registry. Below is an explanation designed to help Eligible professionals (EPs) get started and prepared for Meaningful Use (MU) Stage 2 Specialized Registry attestation regarding submission of patient specific controlled substance dispensing information.

- **1** Open an Internet browser window and type the following URL in the address bar: <u>www.hidesigns.com/</u><u>flpdmp</u>.
- 2 Click the Dispenser, and then click RxSentry Dispenser's Upload Site on the left menu.
- 3 Enter your User Name and Password in the authentication window and click OK.
- 4 Click View Upload Reports.
- 5 Click a hyperlink in the **Report Name** column to open an upload report for viewing.
- 6 NOTE: To view reports for a different timeframe, type a start and end date in

the Report Timeframe fields, and then click submit.

A window similar to the following is displayed to meet the MU Stage 2 Specialized Registry objective. The Edit Report serves as proof that you have reported patient specific controlled substance dispensing information to E-FORCSE.
