



Florida's Prescription Drug Monitoring Program

E-FORCSE MEANINGFUL USE ATTESTATION— Submission of Dispensing Information

Florida's Prescription Drug Monitoring Program, E-FORCSE, maintained by the Florida Department of Health (FDOH) meets the definition of a specialized registry. Below is an explanation designed to help Eligible professionals (EPs) get started and prepared for Meaningful Use (MU) Stage 2 Specialized Registry attestation regarding submission of patient specific controlled substance dispensing information.

- 1 Open an Internet browser window and type the following URL in the address bar: www.hidesigns.com/flpdmp.
- 2 Click the **Dispenser**, and then click **RxSentry Dispenser's Upload Site** on the left menu.
- 3 Enter your **User Name** and **Password** in the authentication window and click **OK**.
- 4 Click **View Upload Reports**.
- 5 Click a hyperlink in the **Report Name** column to open an upload report for viewing.
- 6 **NOTE:** To view reports for a different timeframe, type a start and end date in the **Report Timeframe** fields, and then click submit.
