Additionally, pharmacists have the highest utilization rate, 90.7 percent, and have queried the database 20,730,458 times. Among all prescribers, osteopathic physicians have the highest registration rate, 41.5 percent. Overall 28.4 percent of all licensed health care practitioners have registered to use the database. In addition, 79.4 percent of all healthcare practitioners registered to use the database have queried 37,969,588 times.

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


