

E-FORCSE MEANINGFUL USE ATTESTATION— Retrieval of Patient Information

Florida's Prescription Drug Monitoring Program, E-FORCSE, maintained by the Florida Department of Health (FDOH) has identified itself as a specialized registry for Meaningful Use (MU) Stage 2. EPs may continue to utilize E-FORCSE for MU Stage 3, however, the registry is now classified as a public health registry. Below is an explanation designed to help Eligible professionals (EPs) get started and prepared for Meaningful Use (MU) Stage 3 Public Health Reporting attestation regarding retrieval of patient specific controlled substance dispensing information.



- 1 Open an Internet browser window and type the following URL in the address bar: https://florida.pmpaware.net.
- **2** Enter your **User Name** and **Password** in the and click submit.
- **3** Click on the **Menu** tab on the top menu and then click the **RxSearch/Request History** link.
- 4 Enter the Advanced Options button and enter the Request Begin Date and Request End Date and click Search.

A window similar to the following is displayed. The Search History Query will return results based on the User ID and the request begin and end dates. The report contains the patient first and last name, requestor name, request time, status, and date and time requested query was made.

The request history report serves as proof that you have retrieved patient-specific controlled substance dispensing information from E-FORCSE database and may be used as evidence that you have met the MU Stage 3 Public Health Reporting objective.
