First Ranking Cause

For under 1 year old is [suffocation \(90\)](#),
for 1–4 years old is [drowning \(59\)](#),
for 5–9 years old is [motor vehicle traffic \(14\)](#),
for 10–14 years old is [motor vehicle traffic \(29\)](#),
for 15–24 years old is [motor vehicle traffic \(443\)](#),
for 25–34 years old is [poisoning \(488\)](#),
for 35–44 years old is [poisoning \(555\)](#),
for 45–54 years old is [poisoning \(867\)](#),
for 55–64 years old is [fall \(508\)](#),
and for 65 years old and older is [fall \(2,189\)](#).

For all ages the **first ranking** cause of injury death in Florida is [poisoning \(2,813\)](#).

Second Ranking Cause

For under 1 year old is [drowning \(9\)](#),
for 1–4 years old is [motor vehicle traffic \(13\)](#),
for 5–9 years old is [drowning \(9\)](#),
for 10–14 years old is [suffocation \(15\)](#),
for 15–24 years old is [firearm \(406\)](#),
for 25–34 years old is [motor vehicle traffic \(403\)](#),
for 35–44 years old is [firearm \(342\)](#),
for 45–54 years old is [firearm \(440\)](#),
for 55–64 years old is [firearm \(365\)](#),
and for 65 years old and older is [firearm \(507\)](#).

For all ages the **second ranking** cause of injury death in Florida is [fall \(2,524\)](#).

Third Ranking Cause

For under 1 year old is [motor vehicle traffic \(4\)](#),
for 1–4 years old is [suffocation \(8\)](#),
for 5–9 years old is [poisoning \(3\)](#),
for 10–14 years old is [transport, other \(6 Tied\)](#),
for 15–24 years old is [poisoning \(154\)](#),
for 25–34 years old is [firearm \(385\)](#),
for 35–44 years old is [motor vehicle traffic \(292\)](#),
for 45–54 years old is [motor vehicle traffic \(401\)](#),

for 55–64 years old is [motor vehicle traffic \(328\)](#),
and for 65 years old and older is [motor vehicle traffic \(455\)](#).

For all ages the **third ranking** cause of injury death in Florida is [firearm \(2,457\)](#).

Fourth Ranking Cause

For under 1 year old is [firearm \(3\)](#),
for 1–4 years old is [pedestrian, other \(5\)](#),
for 5–9 years old is [suffocation \(2 Tied\)](#),
for 10–14 years old is [firearm \(6 Tied\)](#),
for 15–24 years old is [suffocation \(107\)](#),
for 25–34 years old is [suffocation \(128\)](#),
for 35–44 years old is [suffocation \(137\)](#),
for 45–54 years old is [suffocation \(178\)](#),
for 55–64 years old is [fall \(160\)](#),
and for 65 years old and older is [suffocation \(288\)](#).

For all ages the **fourth ranking** cause of injury death in Florida is [motor vehicle traffic \(2,382\)](#).

Fifth Ranking Cause

For under 1 year old is [poisoning \(2\)](#),
for 1–4 years old is [fire/flame \(4\)](#),
for 5–9 years old is [fire/flame \(2 Tied\)](#),
for 10–14 years old is [drowning \(4\)](#),
for 15–24 years old is [drowning \(40\)](#),
for 25–34 years old is [drowning \(42\)](#),
for 35–44 years old is [drowning \(47\)](#),
for 45–54 years old is [fall \(99\)](#),
for 55–64 years old is [suffocation \(130\)](#),
and for 65 years old and older is [poisoning \(231\)](#).

For all ages the **fifth ranking** cause of injury death in Florida is [suffocation \(1,083\)](#).

Sixth Ranking Cause

For under 1 year old is [struck by against \(1\)](#),
for 1–4 years old is [poisoning \(3\)](#),
for 5–9 years old is [fall \(2 Tied\)](#),
for 10–14 years old is [poisoning \(2\)](#),
for 15–24 years old is [cut, pierce \(18\)](#),
for 25–34 years old is [cut, pierce \(38\)](#),
for 35–44 years old is [fall \(36\)](#),
for 45–54 years old is [drowning \(74\)](#),
for 55–64 years old is [drowning \(69\)](#),
and for 65 years old and older is [drowning \(87\)](#).

For all ages the **sixth ranking** cause of injury death in Florida is [drowning \(440\)](#).

Seventh Ranking Cause

For under 1 year old is [blank](#),
for 1–4 years old is [fall \(2 Tied\)](#),
for 5–9 years old is [firearm \(2 Tied\)](#),
for 10–14 years old is [fall \(1 Tied\)](#),
for 15–24 years old is [fall \(17\)](#),
for 25–34 years old is [transport, other \(17\)](#),
for 35–44 years old is [cut, pierce \(33\)](#),
for 45–54 years old is [cut, pierce \(28\)](#),
for 55–64 years old is [cut, pierce \(27\)](#),
and for 65 years old and older is [fire/flame \(57\)](#).

For all ages the **seventh ranking** cause of injury death in Florida is [cut, pierce \(164\)](#).

Eighth Ranking Cause

For under 1 year old is [blank](#),
for 1–4 years old is [other natural/environmental \(2 Tied\)](#),
for 5–9 years old is [cut, pierce \(1 Tied\)](#),
for 10–14 years old is [other natural/environmental \(1 Tied\)](#),
for 15–24 years old is [transport, other \(7\)](#),
for 25–34 years old is [fire/flame \(9\)](#),
for 35–44 years old is [transport, other \(15\)](#),
for 45–54 years old is [transport, other \(23\)](#),
for 55–64 years old is [fire/flame \(24\)](#),
and for 65 years old and older is [transport, other \(26\)](#).

For all ages the **eighth ranking** cause of injury death in Florida is [fire/flame \(124\)](#).

Ninth Ranking Cause

For under 1 year old is [blank](#),
for 1–4 years old is [firearm \(1 Tied\)](#),
for 5–9 years old is [transport, other \(1 Tied\)](#),
for 10–14 years old is [blank](#),
for 15–24 years old is [other natural/environmental \(6\)](#),
for 25–34 years old is [pedestrian, other \(5\)](#),
for 35–44 years old is [fire/flame \(8 Tied\)](#),
for 45–54 years old is [fire/flame \(17\)](#),
for 55–64 years old is [transport, other \(18\)](#),
and for 65 years old and older is [cut, pierce \(19 Tied\)](#).

For all ages the **ninth ranking** cause of injury death in Florida is [transport, other \(113\)](#).

Tenth Ranking Cause

For under 1 year old is [blank](#),
for 1–4 years old is [struck by against \(1 Tied\)](#),
for 5–9 years old is [blank](#),

for 10–14 years old is blank,
for 15–24 years old is pedestrian, other (5),
for 25–34 years old is other natural/environmental (4),
for 35–44 years old is struck by against (8 Tied),
for 45–54 years old is pedestrian, other (9),
for 55–64 years old is pedestrian, other (9),
and for 65 years old and older is pedestrian, other (19 Tied).

For all ages the **tenth ranking** cause of injury death in Florida is pedestrian, other (55).
