First Ranking Cause for under 1 years old is fall (317), for 1-4 years old is fall (676), for 5-9 years old is fall (709), for 10-14 years old is fall (560), for 15-24 years old is motor vehicle traffic (3,090), for 25-34 years old is poisoning (3,201), for 35-44 years old is poisoning (3,494), for 45-54 years old is poisoning (4,591), for 55-64 years old is fall (5,560), and for 65 years old and older is fall (42,756). For all ages the first ranking cause of non-fatal injury hospitalization in Florida is fall (58,350).

Second Ranking Cause for under 1 years old is motor vehicle traffic (41), for 1-4 years old is poisoning (431), for 5-9 years old is motor vehicle traffic (257), for 10-14 years old is motor vehicle traffic (309), for 15-24 years old is poisoning (2,737), for 25-34 years old is motor vehicle traffic (2,356), for 35-44 years old is motor vehicle traffic (2,043), for 45-54 years old is fall (3,829), for 55-64 years old is poisoning (2,545), and for 65 years old and older is motor vehicle traffic (2,425). For all ages the second ranking cause of non-fatal injury hospitalization in Florida is poisoning (19,704).

Third Ranking Cause for under 1 years old is hot object or substance (40) (tied), for 1-4 years old is hot object or substance (188), for 5-9 years old is struck by or against (96), for 10-14 years old is struck by or against (214), for 15-24 years old is fall (1,037), for 25-34 years old is fall (1,111), for 35-44 years old is fall (1,795), for 45-54 years old is motor vehicle traffic (2,491), for 55-64 years old is motor vehicle traffic (1,684), and for 65 years old and older is poisoning (2,398). For all ages the third ranking cause of non-fatal injury hospitalization in Florida is motor vehicle traffic (14,866).

Fourth Ranking Cause for under 1 years old is poisoning (40) (tied), for 1-4 years old is motor vehicle traffic (170), for 5-9 years old is transport, other (81), for 10-14 years old is poisoning (198), for 15-24 years old is struck by or against (935), for 25-34 years old is struck by or against (699), for 35-44 years old is struck by or against (581), for 45-54 years old is struck by or against (678), for 55-64 years old is struck by or against (325), and for 65 years old and older is overexertion (606). For all ages the fourth ranking cause of non-fatal injury hospitalization in Florida is struck by or against (4,174).

Fifth Ranking Cause for under 1 years old is suffocation (34), for 1-4 years old is drowning or submersion (161), for 5-9 years old is pedalcylist, other (70), for 10-14 years old is transport, other (153), for 15-24 years old is firearm (719), for 25-34 years old is cut or pierce (607), for 35-44 years old is cut or pierce (521), for 45-54 years old is cut or pierce (429), for 55-64 years old is cut or pierce (233), and for 65 years old and older is struck by or against (526). For all ages the fifth ranking cause of non-fatal injury hospitalization in Florida is cut or pierce (2,697).

Sixth Ranking Cause for under 1 years old is struck by or against (28), for 1-4 years old is struck by or against (92), for 5-9 years old is poisoning (69), for 10-14 years old is pedalcylist, other (114), for 15-24 years old is cut or pierce (597), for 25-34 years old is firearm (498), for 35-44 years old is transport, other (365), for 45-54 years old is transport, other (348), for 55-64 years old is pedalcylist, other (222), and for 65 years old and older is transport, other (305). For all ages the sixth ranking cause of non-fatal injury hospitalization in Florida is transport, other (2,180).

Seventh Ranking Cause for under 1 years old is drowning or submersion (11), for 1-4 years old is bites and stings (82), for 5-9 years old is bites and stings (66), for 10-14 years old is cut or pierce (56), for 15-24 years old is transport, other (390), for 25-34 years old is transport, other (306), for 35-44 years old is firearm (222), for 45-54 years old is pedalcylist, other (270), for 55-64 years old is transport, other (213), and for 65 years old and older is pedalcylist, other (279). For all ages the seventh ranking cause of non-fatal injury hospitalization in Florida is firearm (1,762).

Eighth Ranking Cause for under 1 years old is bites and stings (7), for 1-4 years old is suffocation (39), for 5-9 years old is hot object or substance (51), for 10-14 years old is overexertion (45), for 15-24 years old is overexertion (125), for 25-34 years old is overexertion (155), for 35-44 years old is overexertion (200), for 45-54 years old is overexertion (191), for 55-64 years old is overexertion (194), and for 65 years old and older is cut or pierce (213). For all ages the eighth ranking cause of non-fatal injury hospitalization in Florida is overexertion (1,546).

Ninth Ranking Cause for under 1 years old is fire or flame (5) (tied), for 1-4 years old is fire or flame (29), for 5-9 years old is drowning or submersion (39), for 10-14 years old is bites and stings (30), for 15-24 years old is pedalcylist, other (117), for 25-34 years old is bites and stings (145), for 35-44 years old is bites and stings (146), for 45-54 years old is bites and stings (180), for 55-64 years old is bites and stings (180), for 55-64 years old is bites and stings (130), and for 65 years old and older is other natural, environment (149). For all ages the ninth ranking cause of non-fatal injury hospitalization in Florida is pedalcylist, other (1,345).

Tenth Ranking Cause for under 1 years old is other natural, environment (5) (tied), for 1-4 years old is pedalcylist, other (28), for 5-9 years old is cut or pierce (25), for 10-14 years old is firearm (25), for 15-24 years old is bites and stings (98), for 25-34 years old is pedalcylist, other (112), for 35-44 years old is pedalcylist, other (133), for 45-54 years old is firearm (166), for 55-64 years old is firearm (92), and for 65 years old and older is suffocation (130). For all ages the tenth ranking cause of non-fatal injury hospitalization in Florida is bites and stings (1,004).
