For under 1 year old is [fall \(277\)](#),  
for 1–4 years old is [fall \(505\)](#),  
for 5–9 years old is [fall \(654\)](#),  
for 10–14 years old is [fall \(509\)](#),  
for 15–19 years old is [poisoning \(1,210\)](#),  
for 20–24 years old is [motor vehicle traffic \(1,763\)](#),  
for 25–34 years old is [poisoning \(2,718\)](#),  
for 35–44 years old is [poisoning \(2,840\)](#),  
for 45–54 years old is [fall \(3,902\)](#),  
for 55–64 years old is [fall \(7,298\)](#),  
and for 65 years old and older is [fall \(50,734\)](#).

For all ages the **first ranking** cause of non-fatal Hospitalizations department visits in Florida is [fall \(67,951\)](#).

### ***Second Ranking Cause***

For under 1 year old is [poisoning \(61\)](#),  
for 1–4 years old is [poisoning \(346\)](#),  
for 5–9 years old is [motor vehicle traffic \(228\)](#),  
for 10–14 years old is [poisoning \(354\)](#),  
for 15–19 years old is [motor vehicle traffic \(1,045\)](#),  
for 20–24 years old is [poisoning \(1,253\)](#),  
for 25–34 years old is [motor vehicle traffic \(2,437\)](#),  
for 35–44 years old is [motor vehicle traffic \(1,819\)](#),  
for 45–54 years old is [poisoning \(3,839\)](#),  
for 55–64 years old is [poisoning \(3,395\)](#),  
and for 65 years old and older is [poisoning \(3,033\)](#).

For all ages the **second ranking** cause of non-fatal Hospitalizations department visits in Florida is [poisoning \(19,107\)](#).

for 15–19 years old is [struck by, against \(340\)](#),  
for 20–24 years old is [struck by, against \(394\)](#),  
for 25–34 years old is [struck by, against \(684\)](#),  
for 35–44 years old is [struck by, against \(602\)](#),  
for 45–54 years old is [struck by, against \(620\)](#),  
for 55–64 years old is [struck by, against \(494\)](#),  
and for 65 years old and older is [struck by, against \(672\)](#).

For all ages the fourth ranking cause of non–fatal hospitalizations in Florida is [struck by, against \(4,227\)](#).

#### ***Fifth Ranking Cause***

For under 1 year old is [suffocation \(25\)](#),  
for 1–4 years old is [drowning \(121\)](#),  
for 5–9 years old is [pedalcyclist, other \(61\)](#),  
for 10–14 years old is [transport, other \(122\)](#),  
for 15–19 years old is [firearm \(236\)](#),  
for 20–24 years old is [firearm \(378\)](#),  
for 25–34 years old is [cut, pierce \(652\)](#),  
for 35–44 years old is [cut, pierce \(450\)](#),  
for 45–54 years old is [cut, pierce \(448\)](#),  
for 55–64 years old is [pedalcyclist, other \(327\)](#),  
and for 65 years old and older is [overexertion \(593\)](#).

For all ages the fifth ranking cause of non–fatal hospitalizations in Florida is [cut, pierce \(2,573\)](#).

#### ***Sixth Ranking Cause***

For under 1 year old is [motor vehicle traffic \(18\)](#),  
for 1–4 years old is [struck by, against \(104\)](#),  
for 5–9 years old is [poisoning \(58\)](#),

for 10–14 years old is [pedalcyclist, other \(73\)](#),  
for 15–19 years old is [transport, other \(168\)](#),  
for 20–24 years old is [cut, pierce \(283\)](#),  
for 25–34 years old is [firearm \(443\)](#),  
for 35–44 years old is [firearm \(235\)](#),  
for 45–54 years old is [transport, other \(288 Tied\)](#),  
for 55–64 years old is [cut, pierce \(265\)](#),  
and for 65 years old and older is [pedalcyclist, other \(349\)](#).

For all ages the sixth ranking cause of non–fatal hospitalizations in Florida is [transport, other \(1,846\)](#).

### ***Seventh Ranking Cause***

For under 1 year old is [other natural/environment \(13\)](#),  
for 1–4 years old is [bite, sting \(83\)](#),  
for 5–9 years old is [transport, other \(57\)](#),  
for 10–14 years old is [cut, pierce \(52\)](#),  
for 15–19 years old is [cut, pierce \(159\)](#),  
for 20–24 years old is [transport, other \(141\)](#),  
for 25–34 years old is [transport, other \(249\)](#),  
for 35–44 years old is [transport, other \(223\)](#),  
for 45–54 years old is [pedalcyclist, other \(288 Tied\)](#),

For all ages the seventh ranking cause of non–fatal hospitalizations in Florida is [firearm \(1,653\)](#).

### ***Eighth Ranking Cause***

For under 1 year old is [drowning \(121\)](#),  
for 1–4 years old is [fire/flame \(35\)](#),  
for 5–9 years old is [hot object/substance \(52\)](#),  
for 10–14 years old is [bite, sting \(42\)](#),  
for 15–19 years old is [overexertion \(61\)](#),  
for 20–24 years old is [bite, sting \(62\)](#),  
for 25–34 years old is [bite, sting \(144\)](#),  
for 35–44 years old is [bite, sting \(162\)](#),  
for 45–54 years old is [bite, sting \(206\)](#),  
for 55–64 years old is [overexertion \(181\)](#),  
and for 65 years old and older is [cut, pierce \(219\)](#).

For all ages the eighth ranking cause of non–fatal hospitalizations in Florida is [pedalcyclist, other \(1,462\)](#).

### ***Ninth Ranking Cause***

For under 1 year old is [bite, sting \(8\)](#),  
for 1–4 years old is [suffocation \(29\)](#),  
for 5–9 years old is [drowning \(36\)](#),

for 10–14 years old is [overexertion \(39\)](#),  
for 15–19 years old is [pedalcyclist, other \(51\)](#),  
for 20–24 years old is [pedalcyclist, other \(61\)](#),  
for 25–34 years old is [overexertion \(131\)](#),  
for 35–44 years old is [pedalcyclist, other \(130\)](#),  
for 45–54 years old is [firearm \(162\)](#),  
for 55–64 years old is [bite, sting \(161\)](#),  
and for 65 years old and older is [bite, sting \(176\)](#).

For all ages the ninth ranking cause of non–fatal hospitalizations in Florida is [overexertion \(1,352\)](#).

### ***Tenth Ranking Cause***

For under 1 year old is [overexertion \(7\)](#),  
for 1–4 years old is [transport, other \(24\)](#),  
for 5–9 years old is [fire/flame \(25\)](#),  
for 10–14 years old is [fire/flame \(28\)](#),  
for 15–19 years old is [bite, sting \(49\)](#),  
for 20–24 years old is [hot object/substance \(49\)](#),  
for 25–34 years old is [pedalcyclist, other \(109\)](#),  
for 35–44 years old is [overexertion \(123\)](#),  
for 45–54 years old is [overexertion \(156\)](#),  
for 55–64 years old is [hot object/substance \(107\)](#),  
and for 65 years old and older is [other natural/environment \(154\)](#).

For all ages the tenth ranking cause of non–fatal hospitalizations in Florida is [bite, sting \(1,185\)](#).
