

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Introduction

The Florida Department of Health is pleased to release the 2010 Florida Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS) State and County Data Report. This historic surveillance effort would not have been possible without the support of Florida's 67 County Health Departments (CHDs).

The Florida BRFSS has been collecting and reporting health behavior data since 1986. This statewide telephone survey of Florida adults is the only source of state-specific, population-based estimates of the prevalence of various health and health risk behaviors. The purpose of this survey of Florida residents aged 18 and older is to gather information regarding personal health behaviors, selected medical conditions, and the prevalence of preventive health care practices among Florida adults.

The 2010 BRFSS is the third time the county-level survey has been conducted. It was previously conducted in 2002 and 2007. The 2010 county-level survey was developed in collaboration with state and local representatives and better designed to meet the needs of CHD programs by offering options to add county developed questions and increase sample sizes.

Over 35,000 interviews were completed statewide in the 2010 calendar year, with a target sample size of 500 completed surveys in each county.

Clay County has 185,700 adults in the county, and had 487 adults respond to the 2010 countylevel BRFSS survey.

The 2010 BRFSS provides counties and the state with a rich data source to estimate the prevalence of personal health behaviors that contribute to morbidity and mortality among adults in Florida. This report presents the survey data on a variety of issues related to health status, health care access, lifestyle, chronic illnesses, and disease prevention practice.

Because BRFSS respondents are randomly selected, measures of prevalence and mean are subject to random sample errors. Each measure listed in the data tables includes the 95% confidence interval (CI). Measures of prevalence and mean are excluded from the tables for any subpopulation with a sample size less than 30, which would yield statistically unreliable estimates. Available measures from the 2007 county-level survey are included for comparison purposes. The significance of measures with very wide 95% confidence intervals should be interpreted with caution.

The prevalence rates in this report are adjusted, or "weighted" to represent all Florida adults. Weighting is a procedure that adjusts for the chance of an adult being selected to complete the survey and for discrepancies between the adults who completed the survey and the overall population of Florida adults. The data were weighted to the respondent's probability of selection by county as well as age and sex based on 2010 population estimates. Forty-four records were further adjusted during the weighting process.

A1C Test	A blood test used as an indicator of an individual's average blood glucose level over the past three months.
Activities of Daily Living	Usual activities, such as self-care, work, and recreation.
Binge Drinking	Consuming four or more alcoholic drinks for women and five or more alcoholic drinks for men on one occasion.
Blood Pressure Control Measures	Taking prescribed medication, altering diet, exercising, and reducing body weight to control blood pressure.
Blood Stool Test	A test that may use a special kit at home to determine whether the stool contains blood.
Body Mass Index (BMI)	A measure used to estimate the amount of excess body weight. BMI is calculated using self-reported height and weight.
Chronic Joint Symptoms	Expe <mark>rien</mark> cing pain, aching, or stiffness in or around a joint that first began more than three months ago.
Clinical Breast Exam	A medical exam where a doctor, nurse, or other health professional feels the breasts for lumps.
Current Smokers	Adults who have ever smoked at least 100 cigarettes and who smoked on some or all days in the previous 30 days.
Digital Rectal Exam	An exam in which a doctor, nurse, or other health professional places a gloved finger into the rectum to feel the size, shape, and hardness of the prostate gland.
Former Smokers	Adults who have ever smoked at least 100 cigarettes, but did not smoke on any of the previous 30 days.
Health Insurance Coverage	Includes health insurance, prepaid plans such as HMOs, and government plans such as Medicare.
Healthy Weight	Having a Body Mass Index (BMI) between 18.5 and 24.9. BMI is calculated using self-reported height and weight.
Heavy Drinking (also called chronic drinking)	In the previous 30 days, women consuming an average of one or more alcoholic drinks per day or men consuming an average of two or more alcoholic drinks per day.
High Risk Behavior Groups	Those who have had sex with a man who has had sex with other men, used intravenous street drugs, traded sex for money or drugs, tested positive for HIV, had two or more sex partners in the past year, or who had sex with anyone who would be categorized in any of these groups listed.
HIV	Human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) is a retrovirus that causes acquired immunodeficiency syndrome (AIDS), a condition in humans in which the immune system begins to fail, leading to life-threatening opportunistic infections.
Hysterectomy	An operation to remove the uterus (womb) in women.
Joint Symptoms	Experiencing pain, aching, or stiffness in or around a joint.
Mammogram	An x-ray of each breast to look for breast cancer.
Medical Checkup	A general physical exam, not an exam for a specific injury, illness, or condition.
Myocardial Infarction	Commonly known as a heart attack, is the interruption of blood supply to a part of the heart, causing heart cells to die.
Obese	Having a Body Mass Index (BMI) that is greater than or equal to 30.0. BMI is calculated using self-reported height and weight.

Overweight	Having a Body Mass Index (BMI) ranging from 25.0 to 29.9. BMI is calculated using self-reported height and weight.
Overweight or Obese	Having a Body Mass Index (BMI) that is greater than or equal to 25.0.
Pap Test	A cervical cancer screening test in which surface cells from the cervix are examined for cancer or pre-cancer characteristics.
Poor Mental Health	Adults who report that their mental health, which includes stress, depression, and problems with emotions, was not good on 14 or more of the previous 30 days.
Poor Physical Health	Adults who report that their physical health, which includes physical illness and injury, was not good on 14 or more of the previous 30 days.
PSA Test	A Pro <mark>sta</mark> te-Specific Antigen test, also called a PSA test, is a blood test used to detect prostate cancer.
Retinopathy	A complication of diabetes that results from damage to the blood vessels of the light-sensitive tissue at the back of the eye (retina).
Secondhand Smoke	Being exposed to someone else's tobacco smoke in a room (at work or home) during the past seven days.
Sigmoidoscopy/Colonoscopy	Exams in which a tube is inserted in the rectum to view the colon for signs of cancer or other <mark>health</mark> problems.
Tobacco Cessation Services	Medical and/or psychobehavioral treatment that seeks to reduce or eliminate the use of tobacco products.
