

Florida Arbovirus Surveillance (January 1,2010 - January 1, 2011)

Twenty-five West Nile Virus and 93 Eastern Equine Encephalitis confirmed positive horses were reported in Florida in 2010. Five hundred and sixtyfour sentinel chickens tested positive for antibodies to West Nile virus, 172 to Eastern Equine Encephalitis virus, and five to St. Louis Encephalitis virus. For details, please see the weekly surveillance data. Brevard, Collier, Hillsborough, and Monroe counties are under mosquito-borne illness alerts. Clay, Duval, Flagler, Highlands, Indian River, Jackson, Lake, Leon, Miami-Dade, Osceola, Putnam, St. Lucie, Walton, Wakulla, and Washington counties are under mosquito-borne illness advisories.

Geographic clusters may only appear as a single map symbol. Only cases with valid geographic data appear on the map.
