


# 2016 Florida Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS) Data Report

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# Introduction

The Florida Department of Health is pleased to release the 2016 Florida Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS) state and county data. This surveillance effort would not have been possible without the support of Florida's 67 County Health Departments (CHDs).

The Florida BRFSS is a statewide telephone survey that has been collecting and reporting health behavior data since 1986. This survey is the only source of state-specific, population-based estimates of the prevalence of various health conditions and related risk behaviors among Florida residents aged 18 and older. The purpose of this survey is to gather information regarding personal health and risk behaviors, selected medical conditions, and preventive health care practices among Florida adults.

The 2016 BRFSS was the fifth county-level survey to be conducted in Florida. It was previously conducted in 2002, 2007, 2010, and 2013. The 2016 county-level survey was developed in collaboration with state and local representatives and better designed to meet the needs of CHD programs by offering options to add county developed questions and increase sample sizes. Almost 37,000 interviews were completed statewide during the 2016 calendar year, with a target sample size of 500 completed surveys in each county.

Glades County had 10,942 adult residents and 222 adults responded to the 2016 county-level BRFSS survey.

The 2016 BRFSS provides counties and the state with a rich data source to estimate the prevalence of personal health behaviors that contribute to morbidity and mortality among adults in Florida. This report presents the survey data on a variety of issues including health status, health care access, lifestyle, chronic illnesses, and disease prevention practice.

Because BRFSS respondents are randomly selected, measures of prevalence and mean are subject to random sample errors. Each measure listed in the data tables includes the 95% confidence interval. If the confidence intervals overlap, there is no statistically significant difference in the prevalence rates. However, if the confidence intervals do not overlap, there is a statistically significant difference. The significance of measures with very wide confidence intervals should be interpreted with caution. Measures of prevalence and mean are excluded from the tables for any subpopulation with a sample size less than 30, which would yield statistically unreliable estimates.

The prevalence rates are adjusted, or "weighted," by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention to represent all Florida adults. Weighting is a procedure that adjusts for the chance of an adult being selected to complete the survey and for discrepancies between the adults who completed the survey and the overall population of Florida adults. The data were weighted to the respondent's probability of selection by county, as well as age, sex, marital status, race/ethnicity, and education level.

Due to a change in weighting methodology and the inclusion of cellular telephone responses starting in 2011, data from 2016 may not be comparable to data collected before 2011.

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## GLOSSARY

<b>A1C</b>	Medical test that sums up how much glucose has been sticking to the hemoglobin molecule in the bloodstream during the past 3 - 4 months; in general, an A1C of 7% or less is recommended.
<b>Activities of Daily Living</b>	Usual activities, such as self-care, work, or recreation.
<b>Adult</b>	Individual aged 18 years or older.
<b>Aerobic Recommendations</b>	Performance of at least 150 minutes of moderate aerobic activity or 75 minutes of vigorous aerobic activity per week in the past 30 days.
<b>Angina</b>	Most common symptom of coronary artery disease (CAD); chest pain or discomfort that occurs if an area of the heart muscle does not get enough oxygen-rich blood.
<b>Arthritis</b>	Joint inflammation; term used in the public health field to describe more than 100 rheumatic diseases and conditions that affect joints, the tissues which surround the joint, and other connective tissue; pattern, severity, and location of symptoms can vary.
<b>Asthma</b>	Disease that affects the lungs; causes repeated episodes of wheezing, breathlessness, chest tightness, and nighttime or early morning coughing.
<b>Binge Drinking</b>	For women, consumption of 4 or more drinks during a single occasion; for men, consumption of 5 or more drinks during a single occasion.
<b>Blood Glucose</b>	Also called blood sugar; refers to the level of glucose, the main sugar the body makes from the food we eat, that is found in the bloodstream; the state of low blood glucose is known as hypoglycemia (< 70) and the state of high blood glucose is known as hyperglycemia (>130 before meals; >180 one to two hours after the start of a meal).
<b>Blood Pressure</b>	The force of the blood against the artery walls; two levels of blood pressure measured, the highest, or systolic, occurs when the heart pumps blood into the blood vessels, and the lowest, or diastolic, occurs when the heart rests.
<b>Blood Stool Test</b>	A test that may use a special kit at home to determine whether the stool contains blood.
<b>Blood Sugar</b>	See Blood Glucose
<b>Body Mass Index (BMI)</b>	Body Mass Index (BMI) is a number calculated from a person's height and weight; provides a reliable indicator of body fatness for most people; used to screen for weight categories that may lead to health problems.
<b>Cancer</b>	General name for a group of more than 100 diseases; when cells in a part of the body begin to grow out of control, forming new, abnormal cells and sometimes invading (growing into) other tissues.
<b>Cholesterol</b>	A substance the body uses to produce hormones, vitamin D, and food-digesting acids.
<b>Chronic Bronchitis</b>	A long-term condition in which the airways that carry air to the lungs become inflamed and produce too much mucus, making it difficult to get air into and out of the lungs.
<b>Chronic Diseases</b>	Diseases of long duration and generally slow progression (e.g., heart disease; stroke; cancer; diabetes); represent the leading causes of mortality worldwide.
<b>Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD)</b>	Term that refers to a group of diseases that cause airflow blockage and breathing-related problems, including emphysema and chronic bronchitis.
<b>Coronary Heart Disease (CHD)</b>	See Coronary Artery Disease (CAD)
<b>Current Smoker</b>	Combination of every day smoker and some day smoker.

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<b>Depressive Disorders</b>	Mental illnesses characterized by a profound and persistent feeling of sadness or despair and/or a loss of interest in things that once were pleasurable; disturbance in sleep, appetite, and mental processes are a common accompaniment.
<b>Diabetes</b>	General term for diabetes mellitus; disease in which the blood glucose levels are above normal due to either the pancreas not producing enough insulin (Type-1 diabetes) or the body not using its own insulin as well as it should (Type-2 diabetes).
<b>Emphysema</b>	Long-term, progressive disease of the lungs that primarily causes shortness of breath; tissues necessary to support the physical shape and function of the lungs are destroyed; destruction of lung tissue around smaller sacs, called alveoli, makes these air sacs unable to hold their functional shape upon exhalation. See also Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD)
<b>Every day Smoker</b>	Adults who reported smoking at least 100 cigarettes in their lifetime and reported smoking everyday now.
<b>Exercise</b>	See Physical Activity
<b>Fibromyalgia</b>	A musculoskeletal condition causing widespread muscle and joint pain and fatigue.
<b>Flu</b>	Contagious respiratory illness caused by influenza viruses; can cause mild to severe illness, and at times can lead to death. Some people, such as older people, young children, and people with certain health conditions, are at high risk for serious flu complications.
<b>Flu Shot</b>	Influenza vaccine; an inactivated vaccine (containing killed virus) that is given with a needle, usually in the arm; approved for use in individuals older than 6 months, including healthy people and people with chronic medical conditions. The flu vaccine can also be administered by a spray, mist, or drop in the nose called FluMist™; approved for use in healthy individuals between 2 and 49 years old.
<b>Former Smoker</b>	Adults who reported smoking at least 100 cigarettes in their lifetime but reported not smoking now.
<b>Good Mental Health</b>	Adults who reported poor mental health on 13 or less days out of the past 30 days.
<b>Good Physical Health</b>	Adults who reported poor physical health on 13 or less days out of the past 30 days.
<b>Gout</b>	A form of arthritis caused by too much uric acid in the blood that causes pain, stiffness, and swelling of a joint.
<b>Health Behavior</b>	An action taken by a person to maintain, attain, or regain good health and to prevent illness.
<b>Health Care Coverage</b>	Example: health insurance, pre-paid plans such as HMO's, government plans such as Medicare.
<b>Health Care Provider</b>	A person who by education, training, certification, or licensure is qualified to and is engaged in providing health care to patients (e.g., medical doctor; nurse practitioner; physician assistant; registered nurse).
<b>Health Risk Behavior</b>	An action taken by a person that is associated with higher than average rates of morbidity or mortality (e.g., lack of physical activity; poor nutrition; tobacco use; excessive alcohol consumption).
<b>Healthy Weight</b>	Having a body mass index (BMI) ranging from 18.5 to 24.9; BMI is calculated using self-reported height and weight.

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<b>Heart Attack</b>	Most commonly caused by coronary artery disease (CAD); occurs when a section of the heart muscle dies or gets damaged because of reduced blood supply.
<b>Heavy Drinking</b>	For women, consumption of more than 1 drink per day on average; for men, consumption of more than 2 drinks per day on average.
<b>High Blood Cholesterol</b>	Condition where there is too much cholesterol in the blood; increases the risk of coronary heart disease, heart attack, or angina.
<b>High Blood Pressure</b>	Condition where the blood circulates through the arteries with too much force; tires the heart, harms the arteries, and increases the risk of heart attack, stroke, and kidney problems; a systolic measurement of 140 mmHg or higher OR a diastolic measurement of 90 mmHg or higher.
<b>Hispanic</b>	Adults of Cuban, Mexican, Puerto Rican, South or Central American, or other Spanish culture or origin, regardless of race; self-reported demographic variable.
<b>HIV</b>	Human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) damages a person's body by destroying specific blood cells, called CD4+ T-cells, which are crucial to helping the body fight diseases; can lead to acquired immune deficiency syndrome (AIDS).
<b>Hypertension</b>	See High Blood Pressure
<b>Hysterectomy</b>	An operation to remove the uterus (womb) in women.
<b>Inactive</b>	No leisure-time physical activity, performance of aerobic activity for less than 10 minutes at a time, or performance of only non-aerobic activities.
<b>Influenza</b>	See Flu
<b>Insufficiently Active</b>	Performance of less than 150 minutes of moderate aerobic activity or 75 minutes of vigorous aerobic activity per week in the past 30 days.
<b>Kidney Disease</b>	Also called renal disease; general term for any damage that reduces the functioning of the kidney.
<b>Lupus</b>	A chronic inflammatory disease resulting from an attack by the body's own immune system.
<b>Mammogram</b>	Mammography is the process of using low-energy X-rays to examine the human breast; this test is ordered to detect tumors and differentiate between benign and malignant disease.
<b>Mental Health</b>	A state of well-being in which the individual realizes his or her own abilities, can cope with the normal stresses of life, can work productively and fruitfully, and is able to make a contribution to his or her community.
<b>Muscle Strengthening Recommendations</b>	Performance of muscle-strengthening activities, such as activities using body weight, weight machines, free weights, or elastic bands, at least two times per week in the past 30 days.
<b>Never Smoked</b>	Adults who reported smoking less than 100 cigarettes in their lifetime.
<b>Non-Hispanic Black</b>	Adults not of Hispanic culture or origins reporting membership in only the Black race category; self-reported demographic variable.
<b>Non-Hispanic White</b>	Adults not of Hispanic culture or origins reporting membership in only the White race category; self-reported demographic variable.
<b>Non-smoker</b>	Combination of former smoker and never smoked.
<b>Obese</b>	Having a body mass index (BMI) that is greater than or equal to 30.0; BMI is calculated using self-reported height and weight.
<b>Obesity</b>	A condition characterized by being obese.

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## GLOSSARY

<b>Overweight</b>	Having a body mass index (BMI) ranging from 25.0 to 29.9; BMI is calculated using self-reported height and weight.
<b>Overweight or Obese</b>	Having a body mass index (BMI) that is greater than or equal to 25.0; BMI is calculated using self-reported height and weight.
<b>Pap Test</b>	A cervical cancer screening test in which surface cells from the cervix are examined for cancer or pre-cancer characteristics.
<b>Personal Doctor</b>	A health care provider that an adult identifies as their personal health care provider.
<b>Pneumonia</b>	Infection of the lungs, usually caused by bacteria or viruses, that can cause mild to severe illness in people of all ages; signs can include coughing, fever, fatigue, nausea, vomiting, rapid breathing or shortness of breath, chills, or chest pain. Certain people are more likely to become ill with pneumonia (e.g., children aged 5 years or younger, adults aged 65 years or older; adults with disabilities, HIV/AIDS, or who smoke cigarettes).
<b>Pneumonia Vaccination</b>	Pneumococcal vaccine; vaccine given with a needle, usually in the arm; 23-valent pneumococcal polysaccharide vaccine (PPSV23) approved for use in adults 65 years or older as well as in adults 19-64 years who have specific underlying conditions (e.g., immune deficiency, asthma, COPD).
<b>Race/Ethnicity</b>	A measure that combines an adult's ethnicity status (Hispanic/non-Hispanic) and race status (e.g., white; black; other); self-reported demographic variable.
<b>Routine Checkup</b>	A general physical exam; does not include exams conducted for a specific injury, illness, or condition.
<b>Sedentary</b>	Participating in no leisure-time physical activity in the past 30 days.
<b>Sex</b>	The condition or character of being male or female; self-reported demographic variable.
<b>Sigmoidoscopy/Colonoscopy</b>	Exams in which a tube is inserted in the rectum to view the colon for signs of cancer or other health problems.
<b>Smoking</b>	Inhalation of the smoke (gases and hydrocarbon vapors) generated by slowly burning tobacco.
<b>Some Day Smoking</b>	Adults who reported smoking at least 100 cigarettes in their lifetime and reported smoking some days now.
<b>Stroke</b>	Sometimes called a brain attack; occurs when a clot blocks the blood supply to the brain or when a blood vessel in the brain bursts.
<b>Tetanus</b>	A bacterial infection that affects the central nervous system and can result in painful muscle spasms, stiff jaw, and potentially death.
<b>Tetanus Shot</b>	Tetanus vaccine; vaccine given with a needle, usually in the shoulder muscle; a booster tetanus vaccine should be received every ten years.
