Dolutegravir 5 mg tablet for suspension	Tivicay PD	INSTI
Emtricitabine 10 mg/mL solution	Emtriva	NRTI
Lamivudine 10 mg/mL solution	Epivir	NRTI
Nevirapine 50 mg/5 mL suspension	Viramune	NNRTI
Raltegravir 100 MG packets (granules for suspension)	Isentress	INSTI
Zidovudine 50 mg/5 mL syrup	Retrovir	NRTI
