## What to Print

The compressed file has two versions of this poster.

- 1. The adobe pdf file is intended to be filled out by hand.
- 2. The word version is designed as a Microsoft form and may be filled out using Microsoft word.

If the formatting in the word version is too large for the names or phones numbers to fit, one can reformat the text by unprotect the form (turn on the forms tool bar and select the lock icon).

## How To Print:

This poster contains contact instructions and basic contamination control procedures. In order to be visible, the Emergency Notification Poster should be printed on yellow or canary colored paper.

Most color printers have as an option to emulate LaserJet margins. We recommend that this option be turned on.

## Why color printer and paper?

During a radioactive contamination incident, emotions may be elevated and individuals need to readily find this information. One method of accomplishing this is to use color.

This poster is intended to *provide emergency contact information* in the event of a radioactive contamination spill or release. This information needs to be easily identified during the initial stages of the event.

The poster also provides **basic contamination control procedures** that should be followed to prevent the spread of radioactive contamination during the initial stages of the incident before guidance is obtained from the Radiation Safety Officer.
