Requirements for Advance Notification for the Shipment of Low Level Radioactive Waste

This information notice is applicable to state of Florida radioactive materials licensees who generate or transport Low Level Radioactive Waste.

The purpose of this information notice is to raise the awareness concerning the 48 hour advance notification requirement to the Department of Health, Bureau of Radiation Control for the shipment of Low Level Radioactive Waste.

Section 64E-5.1508, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), requires all persons licensed by the department, as well as nuclear power plants licensed by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, and who desire to ship radioactive waste to a low-level radioactive waste treatment, storage or disposal facility, shall notify the **department no less than 48 hours prior to departure of the shipment.** The notification shall be made in writing or by telephone to:
