

Notice to Health Care Providers Regarding Measles

Measles cases in Broward County and a travel-related case in Central Florida have been reported to the Florida Department of Health (Department). Because measles is highly contagious, the Department is providing the <u>linked</u> <u>information</u> to health care providers regarding the identification, testing, and management of suspected cases.

Suspected measles cases are required to be reported immediately to your local <u>county health department</u> or the Department's Bureau of Epidemiology to ensure prompt response and public health efforts (section 381.0031, Florida Statutes, and Rule 64D-3.029, Florida Administrative Code).
