


This report was created to assess antibiotic stewardship programs and activities in Florida acute care hospitals. Antibiotic stewardship data was evaluated using responses from the 2023 NHSN Patient Safety Component, Annual Hospital Survey.

A total of 226 facilities in Florida completed this survey.






Antibiotic resistance patterns are monitored by their stewardship team (% of facilities)




Antibiotic use in defined daily doses (DDD) is monitored by stewardship team (% of facilities)




Antibiotic expenditures monitored at least quarterly by stewardship team (% of facilities)




Antibiotic use in days of therapy (DOT) monitored by stewardship team (% of facilities)




Stewardship program engages nurses to track antibiotic duration of therapy (% of facilities)




% of facilities with preauthorization for specific antibiotic agents




% of facilities with facility-specific treatment recommendations



% of facilities with formal procedure for shortest effective duration




ASP provides individual or prescriber-level reports on antibiotic use to prescribers, at least annually (% of facilities)




ASP provides unit or service reports to prescribers, at least annually (% of facilities)




Pharmacists receive at least annual education on appropriate antibiotic use (% of facilities)



Prescribers receive at least annual education on appropriate antibiotic use (% of facilities)




Nursing staff receive at least annual education on appropriate antibiotic use (% of facilities)




Patients are provided education on important side effects of prescribed antibiotics (% of facilities)






