



ESSENCE-FL: HL7 Messaging Quick Reference Guide

Purpose

This guide contains specifications for the collective data elements needed to meet the State of Florida's criteria for the Stage 3 Meaningful Use syndromic surveillance menu option. This guide should serve as a complement to the PHIN Messaging Guide for Syndromic Surveillance that was developed by the International Society for Disease Prevention in response to the Meaningful Use legislation. Relevant notes on how our system works:

- Messages are grouped into a visit based on matching the values in EVN-7.1, PID-3, and the month/day in PV-1.44.
- A visit will be flagged as “admitted” from the ED in our system if a message is received with a value of “I” in PV-1.2 or “09” in PV-1.36.
- For Hospitals – We only accept messages on patients whose encounter originated in the Emergency Department. We can receive update messages on those patients once admitted. We cannot receive messages on patients who are direct admits and did not go through the ED.
- Please be sure to suppress fields containing patient identifiable information (such as patient name, next of kin, PID-11.1 and PID-11.2, SSN, etc.)
