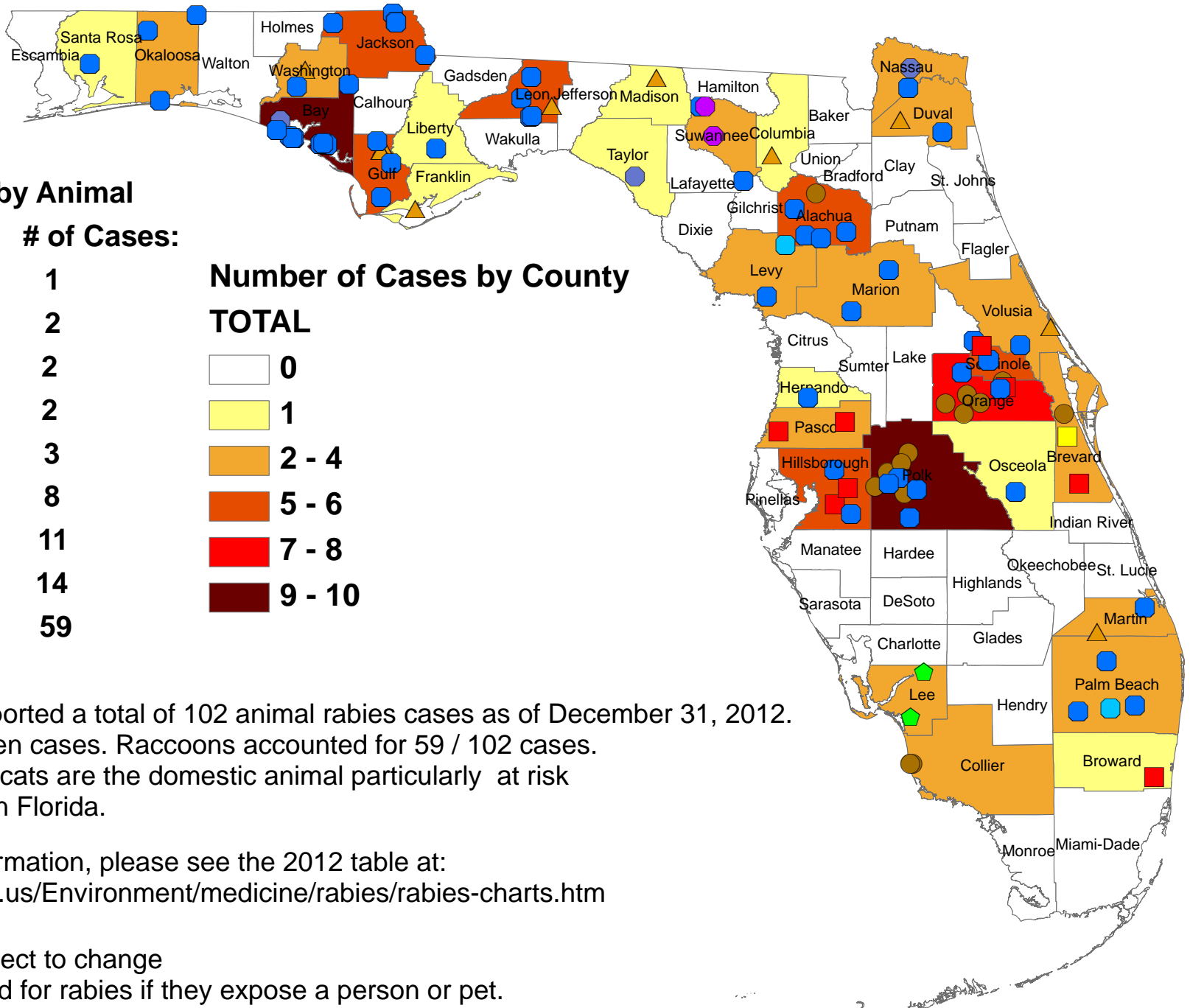




# Reported Animal Rabies in Florida

Thirty-two counties reported a total of 102 animal rabies cases as of December 31, 2012. Bay County reported ten cases. Raccoons accounted for 59 / 102 cases. Unvaccinated outdoor cats are the domestic animal particularly at risk for developing rabies in Florida.
