Dear Mr. Anderson:

This letter is to provide you with permission to proceed with work in accordance with the current executed contract CORCL, including all amendments and renewals, and based on the appropriations of the legislature, for the "Florida Onsite Sewage Nitrogen Reduction Strategies Study: Technology Evaluation, Characterization of Environmental Fate and Transport, and an Assessment of Costs".

Specific authorization is provided to utilize up to an additional \$8,093 of Task C.30 Change-order allowance funds as cost reimbursement for the abandonment of monitoring wells at the soil and groundwater monitoring sites C-HS3 and C-HS4. The change is necessary because the unanticipated need to hire a licensed well contractor to perform parts of Task C. 26 (Draft Site Summary and Closeout Report). The estimated costs are based on the quote provided with your request of April 25, 2014.

Specific authorization is provided to utilize up to an additional \$24,000 of Task B.16 Change-order allowance funds for additional testing to Florida's product composition rule (64E-6.0151, Florida Administrative Code). Per your proposal of May 15, 2014, the costs are based on the price per assessment for Task A.16 (\$4,000) and six installed experimental systems from which you will obtain two samples each, one of which will be the effluent. The change is beneficial for the project because it thoroughly addresses concerns about experimental treatment byproducts for a variety of operating conditions. The testing will include acute definitive toxicity testing and volatile organic compounds determination by EPA method 8260 with a detection limit of 0.5 ug/L in most cases, and supplemental analysis by EPA method 504.1 for 1,2-dibromo-3-chloropropopane and 1,2-dibromoethane to address higher method detection limits of 8260 and lower criteria for these compounds as given in the list the Department uses to determine non-compliance.

Dear Mrs. Ursin,

For the Florida Department of Health Contract CORCL Nitrogen Reduction Strategies Study, we are currently in the process of completing Task C.26 Draft Site Summary and Close-out Report for field sites C-HS3 and C-HS4. We will need to remove or abandon the groundwater monitoring wells at these sites.

Current regulations (Southwest Florida Water Management District, Chapter 40D-3, Regulation of Wells) require that a water well contractor with a license from the State of Florida plug the abandoned wells. This was not included in our scope and budget for this work. We have received the attached quote from the drilling company (Environmental Drilling Service, Inc.) that installed the wells.
