RADIOACTIVE MATERIAL LICENSE CATEGORIES AND FEE REVISONS

Effective August 16, 2007, Section 64E-5.204, Florida Administrative Code is, revised. This revision of the Florida Administrative Code changes the license categories described in our Information Notice 2007-05 and in the table below. This revision also increases all fees for radioactive material license categories in the State of Florida. Note that our licensing fees have not been increased since 1998. Please refer to Regulatory Guide 6.20, Revision 5, dated August 2007, for detailed information on the category changes and new fees. Devices or products in inactive status more than 5 years must submit another application fee and be re-evaluated.
7B No annual fees	7B Adds Annual fees	Safety evaluation of sealed sources containing radioactive material, for commercial distribution or in accordance with the unique specifications of, and for use by, a single applicant; per source remaining in active status. Sources in inactive status more than 5 years must submit another application fee and be re-evaluated
