### Division of Medical Quality Assurance Provides Online Application Process for Nursing Applicants

The Florida Department of Health (DOH) Division of Medical Quality Assurance (MQA) announces that nursing applicants who apply for licensure in Florida now have an improved online application to speed-up the process. MQA launched its new online nursing application on July 1st. MQA anticipates that this improvement coupled with the new criminal background fingerprint scanning program will reduce the amount of time it takes to process licensing applications. For example, nursing applicants who apply to sit for the licensing exam could be scheduled as quickly as two to three days.

MQA's fingerprint scanning program, implemented in November 2007, allows staff processing applications for professions requiring a background screen, such as nurses, to electronically submit scanned fingerprint cards to the Florida Department of Law Enforcement and Federal Bureau of Investigation for criminal background screenings. This reduces the screening response time from six weeks to three days.

"Health care professional shortages impact health care access. We have a strategic objective to license health care professionals as expeditiously as we can while ensuring they meet legal requirements," DOH MQA Division Director Lucy C. Gee, M.S. said. "These are critical steps in achieving that objective."

Once applicants create an account in the Online Licensure Application using an email address and password, they will have up to a year to complete the application and pay the application fee. The online tool is dynamic and keeps the applicant informed of any deficiencies and the current status of their application. It can be used by the following applicants who wish to apply and pay using a credit or debit card:

- Nursing applicants applying to take the exam
- Nursing applicants applying by endorsement from another state
- Foreign nursing applicants

### DOH Investigation Leads to Arrest in Miami

The Florida Department of Health's (DOH) South Florida Unlicensed Activity (ULA) Unit announced that their joint investigation with the Miami-Dade Police Department's Medical Crimes Unit (MDPD-MCU) has led to the arrest of Maritza De La Nuez in connection with the unlicensed practice of dentistry, a third degree felony and punishable by up to five years in prison.

A MDPD-MCU investigation that was initiated from an anonymous tip revealed that Nuez was providing dental services from her residence located at 5417 S.W.. 131st Court. A ULA investigation determined that while Nuez is a licensed Dental Hygienist, she is not currently licensed to practice dentistry in Florida. Nuez asserts that she is a licensed dentist in California. In April of this year, Nuez applied to the Florida Department of Health seeking a license to practice dentistry in this state. That application is currently under review. On Tuesday, July 29, 2008 detectives from the MDPD-MCU made contact with Ms. Nuez at her residence. After being informed of her rights and the allegation against her, Nuez provided a full written confession and allowed the officers to search her home. In her confession Ms. Nuez admitted to treating "patients" at the location for the last five months. The search revealed that she had set up a make-shift dental office in the rear of her residence. The office contained a reclining sofa chair, various dental tools, and a quantity of Benzocaine, a topical anesthetic. After her arrest, Nuez was transported to a local Miami-Dade jail.

DOH has several resources to combat unlicensed activity:

- Complaints may be filed anonymously by completing and mailing the complaint form on the DOH Web site or calling 1-877-HALT-ULA or 1-877-425-8852.

The ULA program protects all people in Florida from the potentially serious and dangerous consequences of receiving medical and health care services from an unlicensed person.

Unlicensed activity is a felony level criminal offense. More importantly, receiving health care from unlicensed people is dangerous and could result in injury, disease or even death.
