| Specimen Source | Blood, Serum |
| Special Specimen Preparation | N/A |
| Minimum Volume | 2mL serum (5-6 mL whole blood). |
| Storage Conditions | Specimens may be stored on or off the clot, red blood cells or separator gel for up to 24 hrs at RT (15- 30C) or up to 6 days at 2-8C. If testing will be delayed more than 6 days, remove serum from the clot, red blood cells, or separator gel and store at -20C or colder. Avoid more than 3 freeze/thaw cycles. |
| Collection Media | Serum (tiger or yellow top SST) preferred |
| Specimen Labeling | Specimen must be labeled with at least two unique patient identifiers, Ex: Name and DOB. Electronic lab order preferred, HMS, Etc. |
| Packaging and Shipping Instructions and Handling | Information on the specimen must match the requisition. Ship in a cooler with ice packs at 2-8C to be received no more than 6 days from collection date. |
| Test Methodology | Chemiluminescent Microparticle Immunoassay (CMIA) |
| Turnaround Time | 96 hours after receipt in the laboratory |
| Result Indicator | See individual tests |
| Unsatisfactory Specimen | Grossly hemolyzed, heat inactivated, pooled and contaminated samples. Cadaveric specimens and fluids other than human serum. Specimens that exceed the storage limitations listed above. Specimens received at 2-8C and >6 days will be cancelled for HBsAg. Specimens received at 2-8C and >7 days will be cancelled for HBsAg, HBsAb, HBcAb and HCVAb. Specimens received at 2-8C and >8 days will be cancelled for all tests. |

| Additional Information & Notes | Panel composed of 3 Hepatitis B tests, Hepatitis C and Hepatitis A (5 tests total). |
| Reference Range | See individual tests |
| Reference Lab | None |
| Reflex testing | All Hepatitis C reactive results will reflex to Test 0390 HCV RNA. If HBsAg is reported as reactive, the specimen needs confirmation and will reflex to Test 0305 Hepatitis B Surface Antigen Confirmation |
