**Goal 6.1:** Build and Enhance a Sustainable System for Preparedness, Response, and Recovery for Disasters and Emerging Public Health Threats

Objective	
6.1.A	Increase the number of ambulance services pre-registered for response in the ESF-8 state ambulance deployment plan (Ambulance Deployment Standard Operating Guidelines) from 0 to 50 by December 31, 2028.
6.1.B	Increase the number of EMS pre-staging areas from 0 to 20 by December 31, 2028.
6.1.C	Increase the percentage of EMS providers who participate in regional health care coalition activities from 54% to 75% by December 31, 2028.
6.1.D	Increase the percentage of licensed 911 ground EMS providers who use an active shooter/hostile events response guideline that is substantially similar to the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) 3000 standard on for preparedness, response, and recovery from an active shooter/hostile event from 55% to 95% by December 31, 2028.

6.2.A Increase the percentage of licensed 911 ground EMS providers providing public outreach for hemorrhage control programs/tourniquet usage substantially similar to Stop the Bleed from 40% to 80% by December 31, 2028.
