# Call to Order, Member Roll Call – Melissa Jordan, Chair and Chancellor Kathy Hebda, Vice-Chair

# Rare Disease Day Event – Jhoanny Cardenas, Florida RareAction Network

Jhoanny Cardenas from the National Organization for Rare Diseases (NORD) Florida RareAction Network (RAN) provided an overview of what Rare Disease Day is and extended an invitation for council members and members of the public to attend the Florida Rare Disease Day virtual event being held on February 25, 2022 and the national Rare Disease Day virtual event being held on February 28, 2022.

Council member Zana Dupee shared about the BioFlorida Legislative Affairs Committee Meeting that occurred on February 7, 2022, in which Kelly Rogers, RDAC coordinator, presented at on the RDAC.

Additionally, Zana provided information on the Rare Disease Day proclamation sponsored by Senator Baxley, which will be formally read before the legislature on February 28, 2022.

# **Overview of Florida's Newborn Screening Program** – Emily Reeves, Florida Department of Health

Emily Reeves, Program Director of the Florida Newborn Screening Program, presented on the Florida Newborn Screening Program, including the purpose of the Newborn Screening Program and the Genetics and Newborn Screening Advisory Council, the conditions included in the newborn screening, locations of referral centers, information on the screening process and how newborns are identified and provided services after being screened.

#### Legislative Annual Report Draft Recommendations – Council Members

Council members gave an overview of all drafted recommendations that have been developed during their individual subcommittee meetings. Members of the council provided feedback and discussion on the recommendations that were presented.

Council members agreed that the March council meeting should be cancelled to provide additional time for subcommittees to meet to work on how recommendations should be formatted into a timeline to be accomplished over the coming years.

#### Public Comment – Melissa Jordan, Chair

A member of the public shared a personal story of their child who was diagnosed with rare disease. Additionally, they shared information on resources related to rare disease empowerment and advocacy, including the EveryLife Foundation for Rare Diseases and the Haystack Project.

A member of the public shared a personal experience regarding their spouse, who suffers from a rare disease, experiencing challenges seeking treatment.
