During the routing process DOH leadership raised the question of how long eligibility for the Postdoctoral Research Fellowship Grants would extend post-graduation. Neither the Research Agenda nor the Funding Opportunity Announcement (FOA) touches on this issue. The most recent version of the FOA specifies the maximum number of years of funding that fellows may receive, and the maximum amount of funding that may be given during that time period, but does not mention any limit on the number of years post-graduation that a postdoctoral researcher may be eligible to apply for funding. In some fellowships, the postdoctoral fellow may be kept on indefinitely. Does the Board wish to put more specific restrictions on this funding mechanism?
