



Dr. Westmoreland is a pediatric surgeon at Nemours Children's Hospital and associate professor of surgery at the University of Central FL College of Medicine in Orlando and an assistant professor of surgery at Florida State University College of Medicine in Tallahassee who completed medical school at the Brody School of Medicine and general surgery residency at Duke University.

While at Duke, she completed a Ph.D. in genetics and genomics. She then completed a pediatric surgical oncology fellowship at St. Jude and her pediatric surgery fellowship at the University of MS Medical Center. Her pediatric surgery practice is centered around pediatric cancer, and she serves on the tumor board for Nemours Children's Hospital and the neuroblastoma committee for the Children's Oncology Group.

She is also the director of her pediatric cancer translational laboratory where she focuses on high risk neuroblastoma and other challenging to treat pediatric tumors. Her funded laboratory has published on using novel agents to treat high risk neuroblastoma, including Zika virus and a novel small molecule. She is dedicated to pediatric oncology research with the goal of translating the results into her pediatric surgery practice.
