



How to Help a Learner Locate and Register for a TRAIN Florida Course

It's a New Day in Public Health

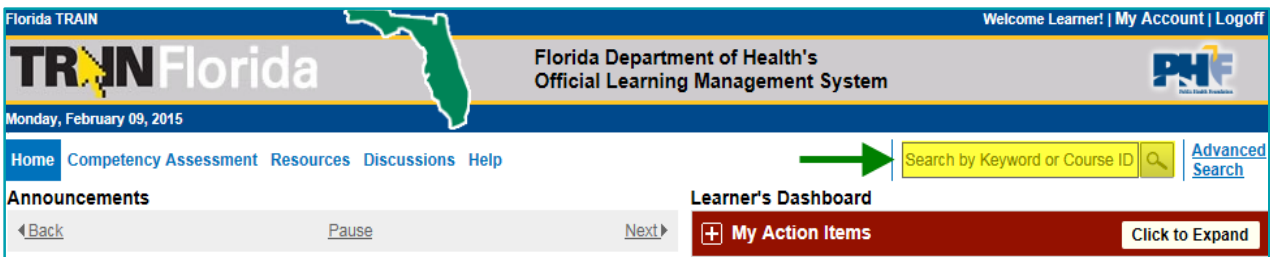
There are several ways for learners to locate and register for courses within TRAIN Florida. This document will focus on locating a course using the Keyword or Course ID search feature, as it is available on all TRAIN Florida pages and is a key search tool for learners in this process.


It is beneficial for you as a Local LMS Administrator to be aware of the steps for locating, and registering for courses in TRAIN Florida to better assist your learners.

To assist a learner with locating and registering for a course, use the following steps:

Step 1: Log in to [TRAIN Florida](#)

Step 2: From the TRAIN homepage – Locate the **Keyword or Course ID** search feature.






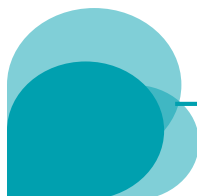
Step 3: If the learner knows the **Course ID** number, have them type it into the search field and click the **Search icon**  button.

The learner can also search by entering a **Keyword** from the title of a course if known, or from the subject they wish to study. For example: the Department uses **FDOH** in front of all titles. After entering the Keyword, click the **Search icon** button.



Step 4: They will be directed to the **Course Search** page. This page lists all courses, live events, resources, and discussion boards with the Keyword(s) in the title.

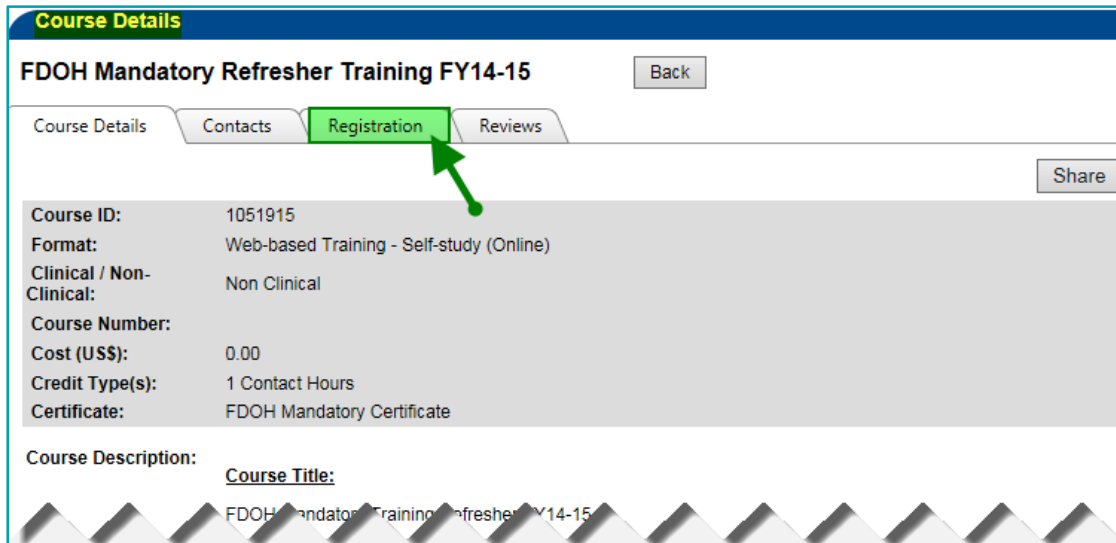

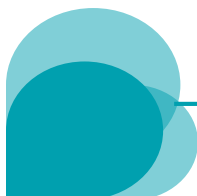
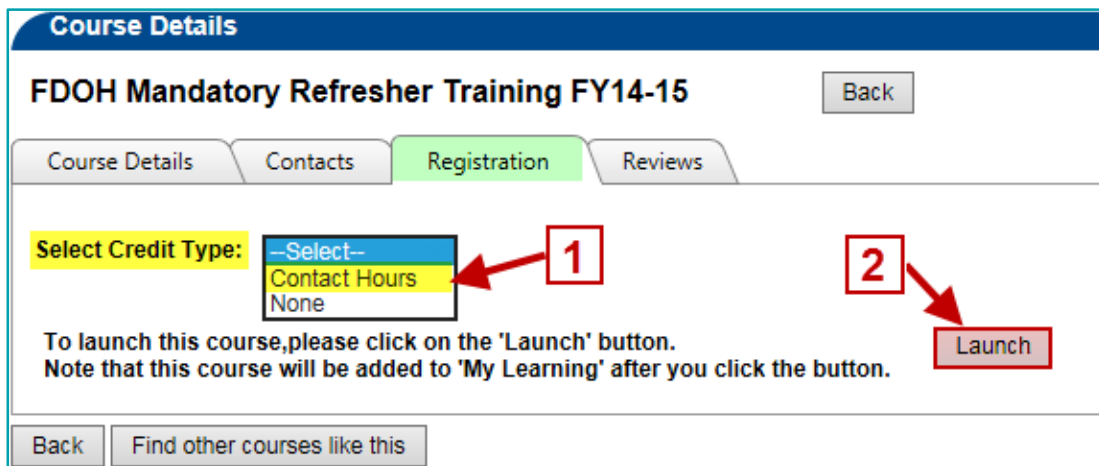
If a prefix was used and the learner knows the name of the course the list can be sorted alphabetically after the prefix by clicking on **Title** in the column header.

Once they have located the course, if the learner would like to register, have the learner **click on the title of the course**.

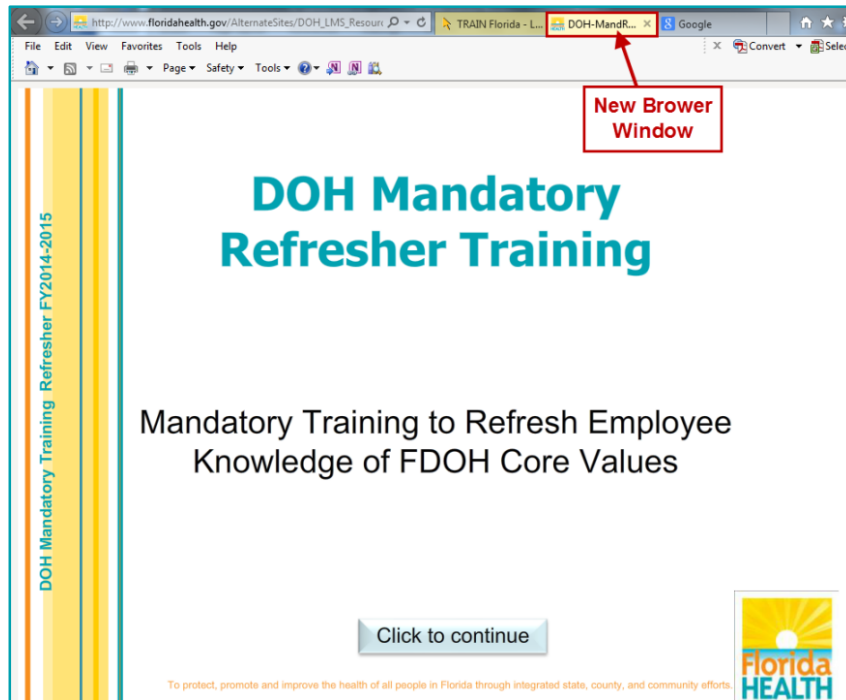
Step 5: They will be directed to the **Course Details** page for their chosen course. Be sure to have the learner review the information on this page. If the course meets their needs, they should click the **Registration** tab.



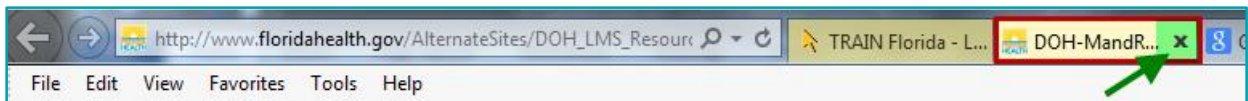
Step 6: Once on the Registration tab – **(1)** Have the learner **Select a Credit Type** from the drop down menu. They should choose a credit type, to have the course record properly on their training transcript. **(2)** To register and begin participating in the course, have the learner click the **Launch** button.



Step 7: The learner is now registered in the course – the course will open and begin playing in a new browser window.



Step 8: The learner can choose to continue viewing and complete the course presentation right away, or watch the presentation later and close the new window by clicking the X in the browser tab, to return to TRAIN Florida.



NOTE: The course will now be listed as In Progress in the learner's My Learning tool, in the Dashboard on their TRAIN Florida home page, and can be re-accessed by the learner at any time.
